



Range Rules / Range Etiquette The 180° Rule

DOWNRANGE






UP RANGE

- The Firing Line, or the 180° Line, is an imaginary line perpendicular to your line of sight when facing downrange (toward the targets).
- Always keep the muzzle of your gun pointed downrange, within this 180° arc! That's the 180° Rule.
- * Each range may have only ONE common Firing Line. This is especially important on Range 1.
- EVERYONE must be behind the Firing Line whenever anyone is shooting.
- * When anyone is downrange of the Firing Line there should be NO handling of firearms and absolutely NO SHOOTING.
- Guns may only be loaded at the Firing Line.
- When not on the Firing Line, guns should be bagged, cased, have a chamber flag or have the action open.

In the Back Pits Our Multi Gun Matches are open to the qualified public, and we always welcome visitors who just want to watch. Multi gun action matches are exciting and fast-paced, and require competitors to be extremely familiar with rules and procedures before participating in matches. You shouldn't think that we don't welcome new shooters though. We'll go out of our way to get you involved. It will be 5-6 stages depending on participation and all 3 guns will be used. We might use slugs, rifle and shotgun slings, this match, and we use all of the 200 yards available on the rifle range. The match fee will be \$25 -\$30 depending on the number of stages.
