TROUT COMMITTEE

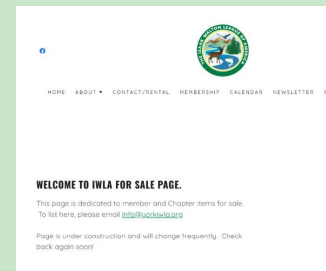

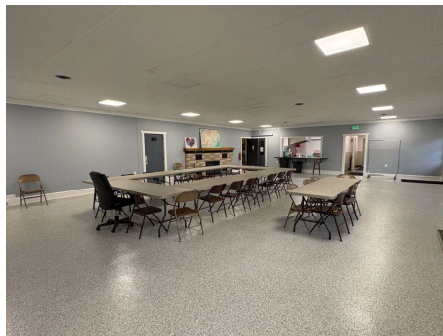
