Range Safety / Range Etiquette

RANGE 1

On Range 1, the 35-yard range, you may shoot from any position in between the two block walls. Please coordinate with other shooters to establish a single Firing Line.

Bring your own target holders. We tried to provide various options over the years, but they get abused and shot up, so for now, you're on your own.

You may bring your own **steel targets** for use on Range 1 but please follow the posted safety rules for distance (minimum 10 yards) and ammo (pistol and

bird shot only). **Only use hardened steel targets specifically designed for your ammunition.**

Remember: No frangible targets on Range 1. The only other target type you can shoot on Range 1 is **Clay Birds** which may be placed on the berm. That means no cans, no glass bottles. It also means **NO BOWLING PINS**. Bowling pins deflect rounds at unpredictable angles creating an unsafe situation.

RANGE 2

On Range 2, the 50-yard range, you may shoot forward of the pavilion by activating the red lights and walking closer to the targets, but only if nobody else wants to shoot from the benches in the pavilion.

Shooters wishing to shoot from the benches in the pavilion have priority over those shooting closer on the 50-yard range regardless of who arrived first.

If you're shooting from a downrange location of Range 2 and someone else shows up who wants to shoot from the benches, please move to the pavilion area or relocate to Range 1.

RANGE 3

Remember that all shooting on Range 3 (100-yd, 200-yd) is from the pavilion area only. And remember to shoot straight downrange only. Please do not shoot across shooting lanes.

On Saturday May 18th, Dallastown Area Intermediate Schools once again graced us with their annual **Trout in the Classroom** trout release. The culmination of months of classroom work, this event attracts many students and their families and includes educational opportunities in trout/stream habitat and management. The students plant trees in our riparian buffer zone, "stream stomp" to collect and assess critters in the stream (a real measure of the health of the stream), enjoy a lesson in trout stocking from IWLA York's trout crew, lessons in Fly Fishing and several other activities. The students also get time to play, rolling our "tube", splashing in the stream, swinging on our playground and generally just being kids!
