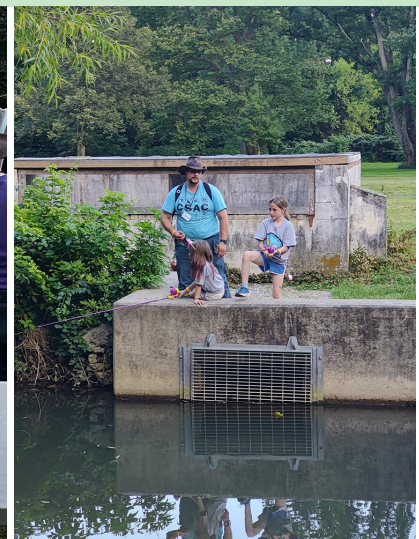

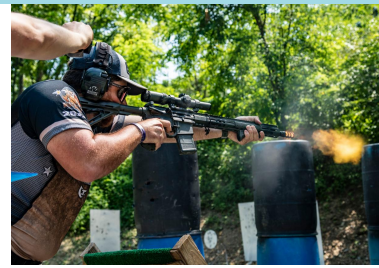

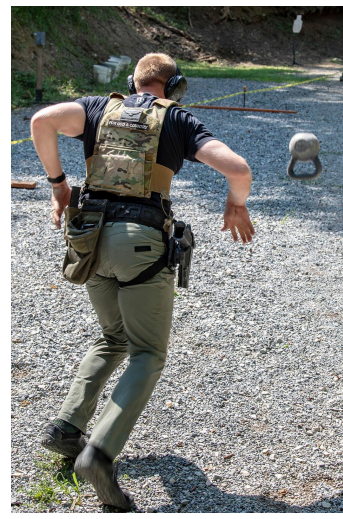

In the Back Pits Our Multi Gun Matches are open to the qualified public, and we always welcome visitors who just want to watch. Multi gun action matches are exciting and fast-paced, and require competitors to be extremely familiar with rules and procedures before participating in matches. You shouldn't think that we don't welcome new shooters though. We'll go out of our way to get you involved.

It will be 5-6 stages depending on participation and all 3 guns will be used. We might use slugs, rifle and shotgun slings, this match, and we use all of the 200 yards available on the rifle range.

The match fee will be \$25 - \$30 depending on the number of stages.
