

Multi gun action matches are exciting and fast-paced, and require competitors to be extremely familiar with rules and procedures before participating in matches. You shouldn't think that we don't welcome new shooters though. We'll go out of our way to get you involved.

It will be 5-6 stages depending on participation and all 3 guns will be used. We might use slugs, rifle and shotgun slings, this match, and we use all of the 200 yards available on the rifle range.

The match fee will be \$25 -\$30 depending on the number of stages.

## **TUESDAY NIGHT EGG SHOOT**

**Every Tuesday Night**

**Set up at 3:30 – 7:00pm**

**May 27th through July 15th**

***NO SIGN UP NEEDED JUST SHOW UP!***

This is a 22lr event only. There are classes for pistol and rifle. No magnum or high velocity ammo, 1280 fps or less. Standard velocity does just fine at 1070 fps and is recommended. If you have a 22lr gun we will find a class for it. You will be competing against others in the same class as your gun.

You do not have to be a York IWLA member to play.

Bring your guns unloaded and in a bag with a chamber flag. (Empty Chamber Indicator, ECI)

There are 10 steel egg shaped and sized targets at each distance.

You must knock them down for them to score.

- For pistol you will shoot standing unsupported at 7, 9, 11 and 13 yards
- For rifle you will shoot standing unsupported at 10, 15, 20 and 25 yards.

## **WALNUT & STEEL MATCH**

**Every Second Wednesday**

**JULY 9th**

**August 13th**

**9:30 am - 11:30 pm**

Monthly event for pre-1960 surplus military rifles, issued from any nation. The match is a very light competition with the emphasis being marksmanship, fun and few firearm regulations (other than safety). All shooting will be done from the bench from a front rest. No rear bags allowed. No prone, or seated on the ground. This is designed for the average shooter, not the high power match competitor. If you're looking for serious competition this will not be a good match for you.

- Only one gun per shooter.
- Military issued rifles (any country) up to and including 1960
- Smokeless powder cartridge only
- No sporterized stocks or barrels and must be in the original issued caliber
- In order to help equalize the sighting improvements over the 100+ year time period this match covers and to help people with poor vision:
  1. Rear peep sights are allowed even if they were not an issued item.
  2. Aftermarket scopes ARE also allowed even if scopes were not an issue item.

**There will be two simple classes:**

1. Optics: Anything using glass.
2. Irons: Iron sights (including rear peeps).
