## Range Safety / Range Etiquette

Firearm safety is a critical responsibility for all gun owners, and keeping the gun unloaded until you're ready to shoot is an important safety rule.

One way to reinforce that rule is to use an **Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI)** often called a **Chamber Flag**—a small brightly colored device designed to show that the chamber of a firearm is unloaded.

Chamber Flags not only ensure peace of mind, help maintain safety at the range, and put other shooters at ease knowing that your gun is unloaded.

We encourage the use of Chamber Flags on all shooting ranges.

## The Complete Combatant Training Weekend

I'd like to take a moment to express my sincere appreciation to the Club for the use of our ranges this past weekend.

IWLA York #67 and SAFE Firearms Training hosted **Brian Hill** of **The Complete Combatant** for a 3-day training event. Friday's Rifle Marksmanship class drew 12 students, followed by the inaugural Pistol Tactician course with 12 students on Saturday and 14 on Sunday.

Brian travels extensively teaching courses across the country, and he was genuinely impressed with our facility. He praised the range for its abundant space, wealth of equipment, and excellent berm construction — high praise from someone who has seen ranges nationwide. He also noted that our \$130 annual membership is exceptional value — clubs near him in Georgia run \$500–\$600 per year, with at least one carrying a five-year waiting list to get in.

The majority of attendees were not current IWLA members, and we welcomed students from as far as New Jersey and the Philadelphia area. Several local attendees expressed interest in attending future matches and asked about joining the Club — exactly the kind of outcome these events are designed to produce.

Given the success of this weekend, I'm hopeful we can bring Brian back in 2027 and continue growing both the training program and our Club's visibility in the regional shooting community. Thank you again for the opportunity — it's clear that York IWLA has something special, and it's worth sharing.
