We will only be using firearms and ammunition provided through the Club, no personal rifles, pistols, or ammunition should be brought into the range facilities.

The event will start at the Clubhouse for classroom instruction and then move to back shooting bays for the shooting portion of the event. Pizza will be provided back at the Clubhouse after we finish shooting.

The First Shots program is free, but there is a \$5 fee for lunch. If you have eye and ear protection, please bring it with you. If you don't have eye and ear protection we can provide it.
