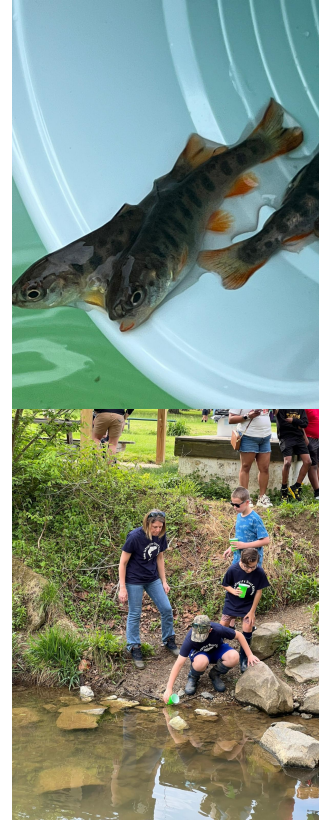
This is our 4th year hosting the release event that included a trout fingerling release, stream stomping for

NO SIGN UP NEEDED JUST SHOW UP!

This is a 22lr event only. There are classes for pistol and rifle.
No magnum or high velocity ammo, 1280 fps or less. Standard velocity does just fine at 1070 fps and is recommended.

If you have a 22lr gun we will find a class for it.

You will be competing against others in the same class as your gun.

You do not have to be a York IWLA member to play. Bring your guns unloaded and in a bag with a chamber flag. (Empty Chamber Indicator, ECI)

There are 10 steel egg shaped and sized targets at each distance.

You must knock them down for them to score.

For pistol you will shoot standing unsupported at 7, 9, 11 and 13 yards

For rifle you will shoot standing unsupported at 10, 15, 20 and 25 yards.

MULTIGUN

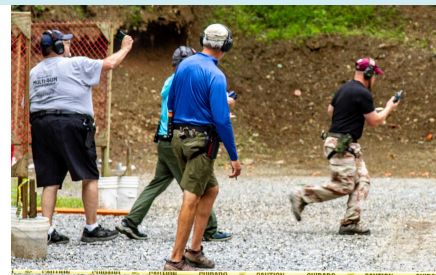

In the Back Pits Our Multi Gun Matches are open to the qualified public, and we always welcome visitors who just want to watch. Multi gun action matches are exciting and fast-paced, and require competitors to be extremely familiar with rules and procedures before participating in matches. You shouldn't think that we don't welcome new shooters though. We'll go out of our way to get you involved. It will be 5-6 stages depending on participation and all 3 guns will be used. We might use slugs, rifle and shotgun slings, this match, and we use all of the 200 yards available on the rifle range.

The match fee will be \$25 -\$30 depending on the number of stages.
