- AmazingReunion — for websites
- Asana - for assigning tasks and tracking progress
- Beehiiv - for designing visual, printable, or PDF programs/newsletters
- Canva - for designing visual, printable, or PDF programs/newsletters
- CheddarUp – for group payment collection
- Cozi - to manage RSVPs, budgets, and shared calendars
- Doodle - for polling family members, quick updates and scheduling
- Dropbox - for sharing updates, itineraries, documents, event photos and videos
- EventCreate - website builder for event planning
- Evite - for sending and tracking digital invitations
- Facebook Groups & Messenger - for family reunion communications and organizing information
- FamilyConnections.com - for planning reunions, build family tree, share albums and preserve family history
- Family Reunion Helper - to create guest lists, manage budgets and send notifications
- Family Wall - for shared calendars, to-do lists, photo sharing, and budgeting
- Flipbook Maker - create and format digital content (newsletters, program booklets, family photo albums, etc.)
- Google Calendar and Forms - for communication, gathering RSVPs, T-shirt sizes, scheduling, organization, sharing docs
- Google Drive - for sharing updates, itineraries, documents, event photos and videos
- Google Meet - for video calls, planning meetings and hosting virtual segments of the reunion
- GroupMe - for family reunion communications: quick updates, reminders, and casual discussion
- iCloud - for sharing updates, itineraries, documents, event photos and videos
- JusTalk Family - for video calls
- Life360 - to track family member arrivals and location sharing.
- Lucidchart - for mapping out family trees and visual collaboration
- Mail Chimp - for email
- Mailer Lite - for email
- Microsoft Copilot - for communication, organization, creating itineraries, finding locations, comparing lodging
- Microsoft Forms - to gather RSVPs, dietary restrictions, T-shirt sizes, or activity preferences
- MyEvent - for creating a website, collecting payments, managing registrations, budgets and shared calendars
- Notion Checklist - for assigning tasks and tracking progress
- Paperless Post - for sending and tracking digital invitations
- Pro Party Planner - to create guest lists, manage budgets, and send notifications
- Reunacy - for websites
- SignUp Genius - for quick updates, scheduling, RSVPs, budgets, shared calendars, dietary needs, task delegation
- Skype - for planning meetings or hosting virtual segments of the reunion
- Trello - for assigning tasks and tracking progress
