- c. Individual County updates:
 - Benton County: Courtney Ferreira provided an update on Benton County's full caseloads and hiring process for the posted 1.0 FTE PHN position; recent Project Connect event with 150 people stopping at the Benton First Steps booth; this week's Babe Café (St. Cloud YMCA) had highest attendance at 22 moms.
 - Stearns County: Janet Goligowski provided an update on Stearn's County Project Connect
 attendance; full caseloads looking forward to expansion funding in 2025; PH coordinator position
 opening; presentation to THRIVE with partners for Family Resource Center overview; continue to
 add new members to PH Taskforce; Opioid work has 8 projects approved including adding PHN
 and in process of developing County Health Ratings dashboard comparing county to MN status in
 Opioid work.
 - Wright County: Sarah Grosshuesch provided an update on Wright County discussions with MDH Strong Foundations grant FHV caseload capacity to address closure/served ration and eligibility for expansion funds in the future; 2 FHV staff on docket to train in MECSH early 2025; moving to implementation of Family Resource Center opening in Howard Lake (new) Public Library and mobile FRC.
 - Sherburne County: Nicole Ruhoff provided an update on Sherburne County caseloads are full, eagerly anticipating 2025 expansion funding with current hiring process for open PHN position; Promise Practices grant growing connections with Latino/Hispanic community organizing Healthcare for All event (78 families attending); FS presenting at MDH Partners in Public Health conference next week and AMC conference in December; MDH pleased with innovatively meeting our FS Community Action Committee requirement leveraging already existing community partner meetings/connections, PH Taskforces, and client input across our region; Family Resource Center at Main Street Family Services moving towards January 2025 opening

	with hiring of coordinator; attendance of Fairview Community Advisory Board (hoping to increase referral partnership); Baby Café/Lactation Connection partnership with ECFE.
