

# **COMMUNITY PARTNER NEWSLETTER**

#### **OUR REGION**



Approximately 440,000 people live across Benton, Sherburne, Stearns & Wright Counties. This includes:

 87% white, 13% persons of color, 5% foreign-born

In 2024, there were 5,377 births to families living in the four-county region

 48% births occurred at a CentraCare Hospital, while 22% births occurred at North Memorial - Maple Grove Hospital

Our First Steps centralized intake averaged 77 incoming FHV referrals a month in 2024. We are currently serving over 340 families in our family home visiting program regionally.

# **OUR SERVICE AREA**



While all MN counties offer Family Home Visiting (FHV), First Steps Central MN covers FHV in Benton, Sherburne, Stearns & Wright Counties



For the second half of 2025, we are:

- in process of updating our First Steps brochure rack card
- developing additional promo videos in both English & Spanish
- planning to send our annual family feedback survey to all enrolled FHV families
- training staff in both 1) Mothers & Babies (a stress-reduction and perinatal mental health curriculum) and 2) Promoting First Relationships (a curriculum they currently use with families but were looking to enhance their knowledge)
