2. Family Home Visiting Updates a. Program Updates & Budget Review (Leah) b. Individual County Updates (Directors)	 Quarter 2 Family Home Visiting Highlights: Outreach & Community Partners – over 50 meetings/events with our community partners Centralized Intake Referrals – referrals from 48 community partners year-to-date (and 94 since inception); 50% of referrals from 4 sources (CC SCH FBC, CC SCH NIUC, WCCA WIC, and CC Family Health Clinic); 5% increase in referrals since last quarter FHV Caseloads – 10% growth from previous quarter, currently serving 322 families & 18 of those cross-county; additionally, 55 families have completed/graduated programming Community of Practice & DEIB – our October CoP session with staff & supervisors will be focused on Hispanic & Latino culture and resources with our community partners Continuous Quality Improvement – continue to improve our process & documentation standardization across our region to strengthen our family engagement & retention; have developed a tool for continued outreach with families that may lose contact that includes creative and continuous outreach to maintain

	 contact and help connect them to further resources in times of change & difficult circumstances (including housing instability, unemployment, mental health crisis, etc) Budget Review & Strong Foundations Funding – 2nd quarter of the first year of the five-year grant cycle; regionally we have expended 48%; begin our 2024 budget planning
