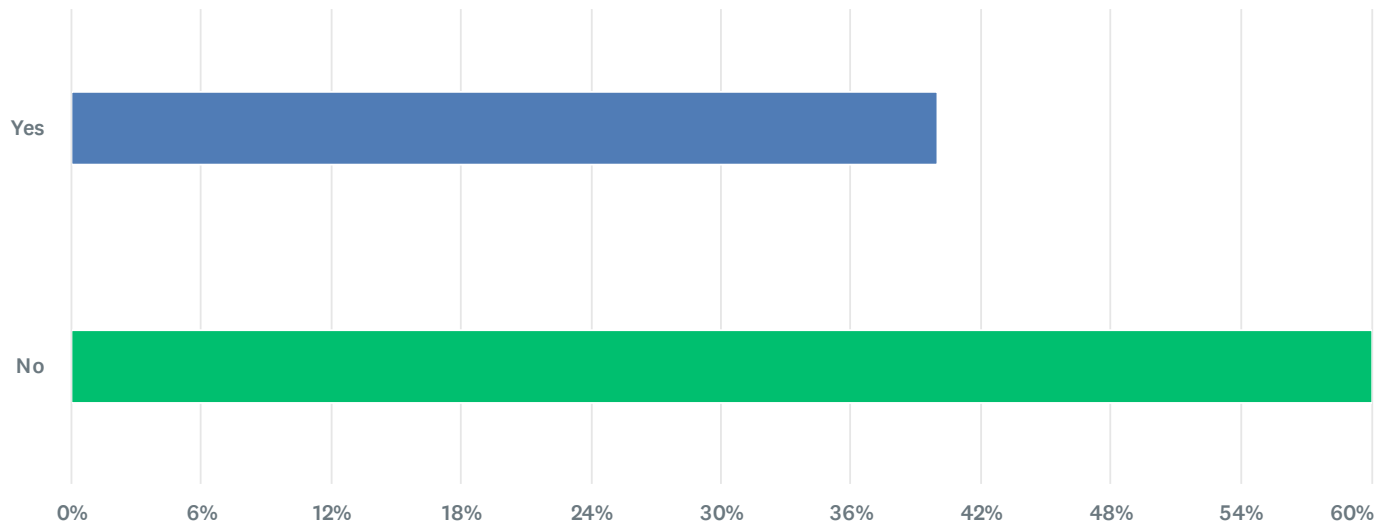

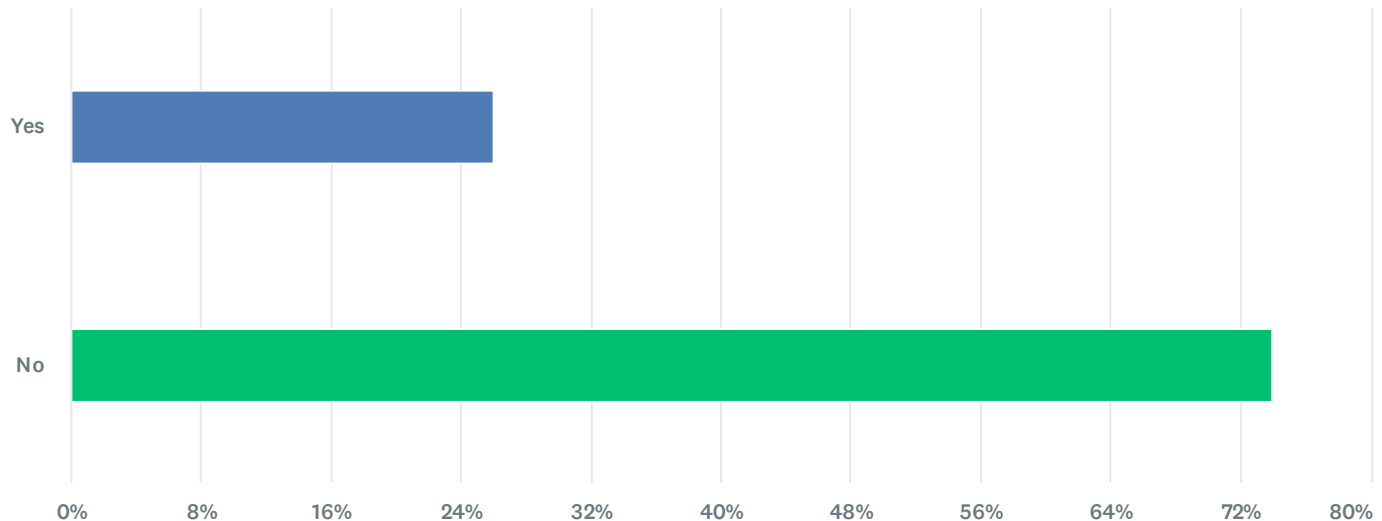

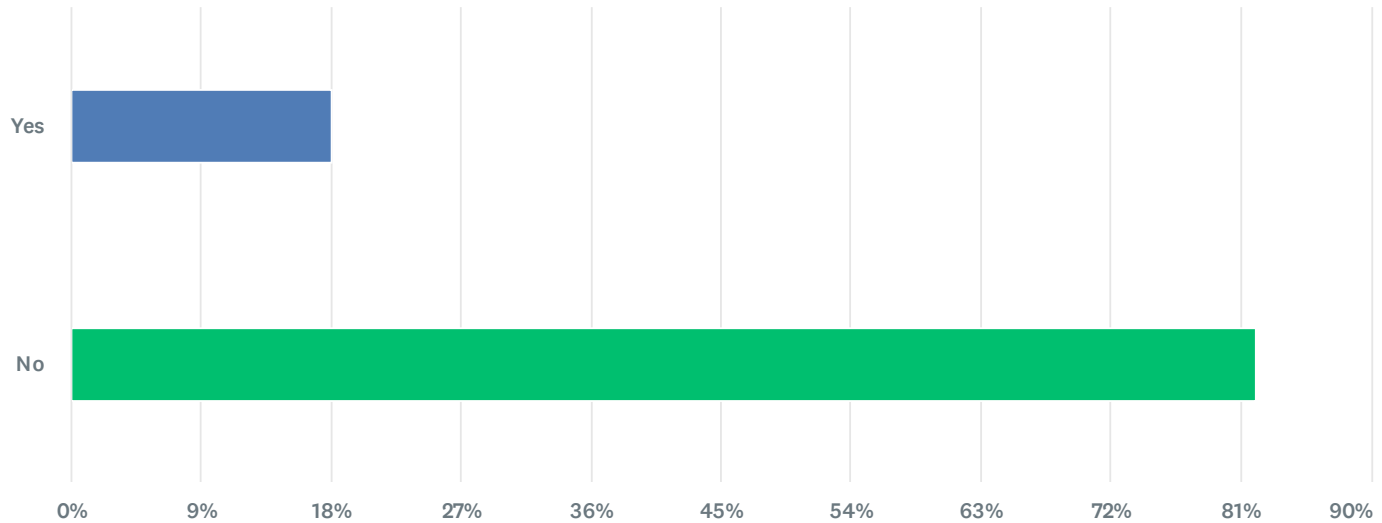

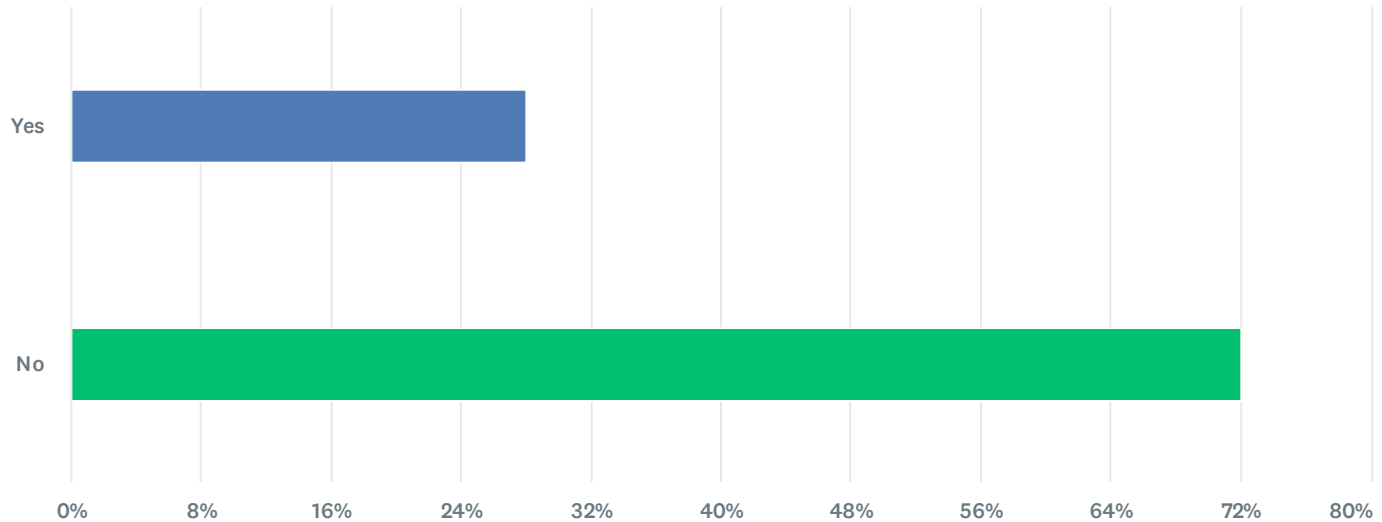
Would you accept speed tables as per Orange County? Speed tables are even wider than speed humps and less aggressive. See attached diagram.

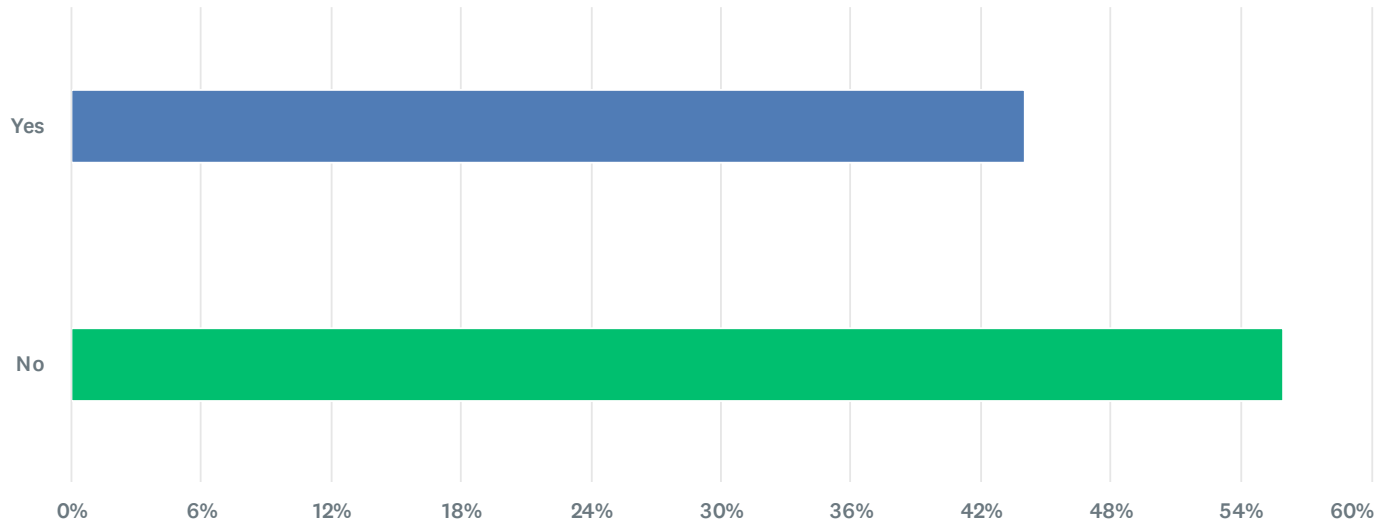

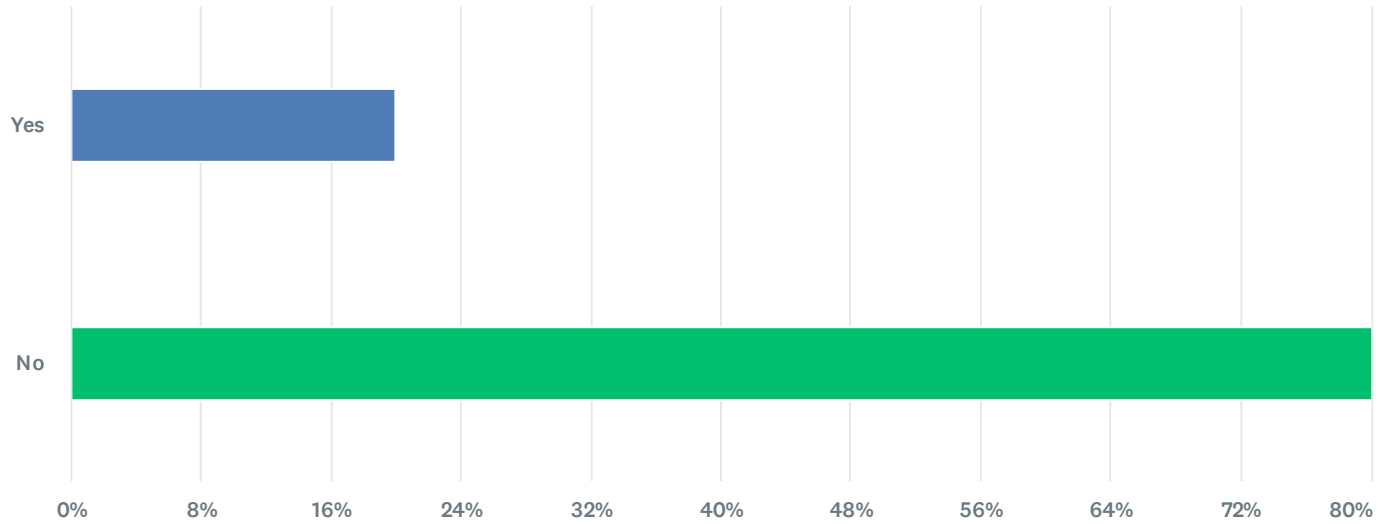
Would you accept placing additional stop signs at various locations in the community?

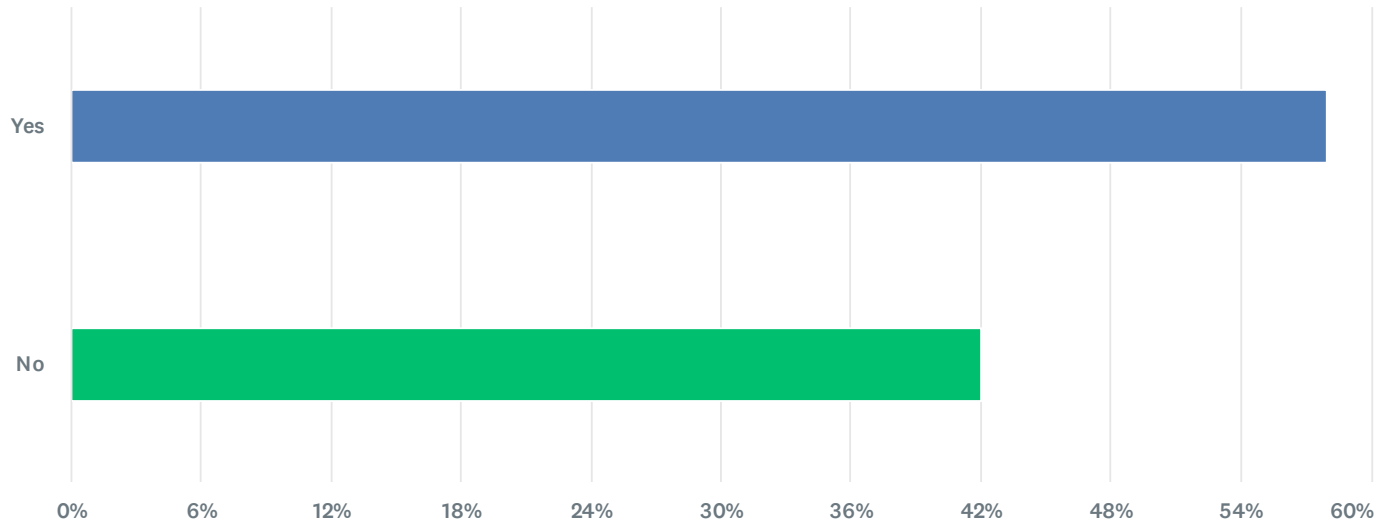
Should we replace the 25 mph speed limit signs with 15 mph signs

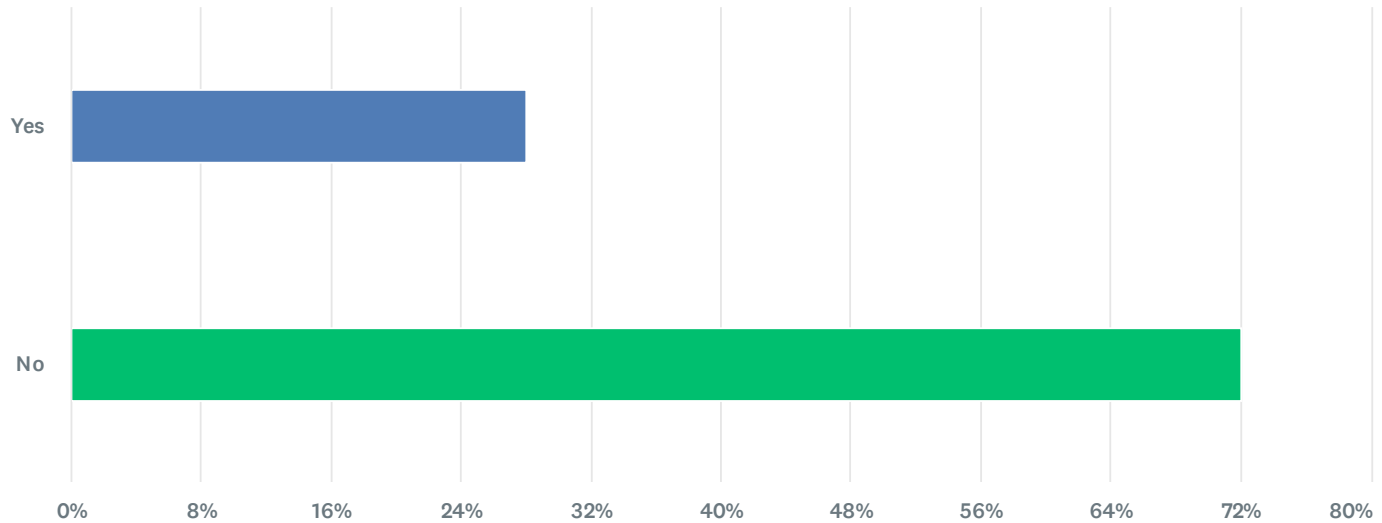
Would you accept flashing signs on Bellezza Drive that flashes the speed a vehicle is traveling ?

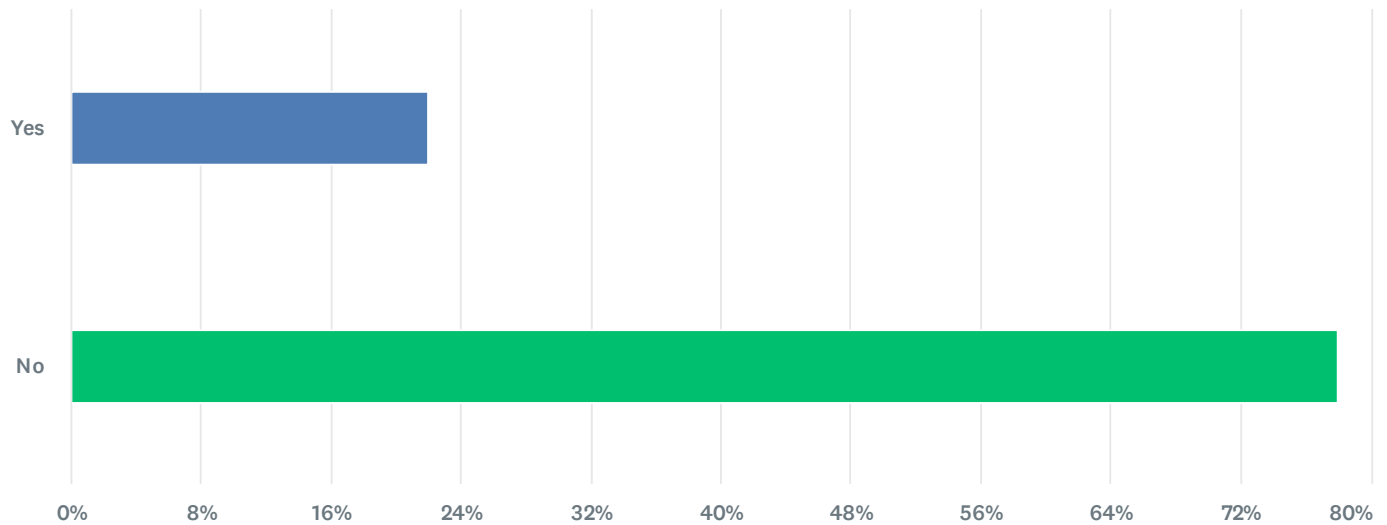
Would you accept installing cameras along with a sign informing drivers that their speed is being monitored?

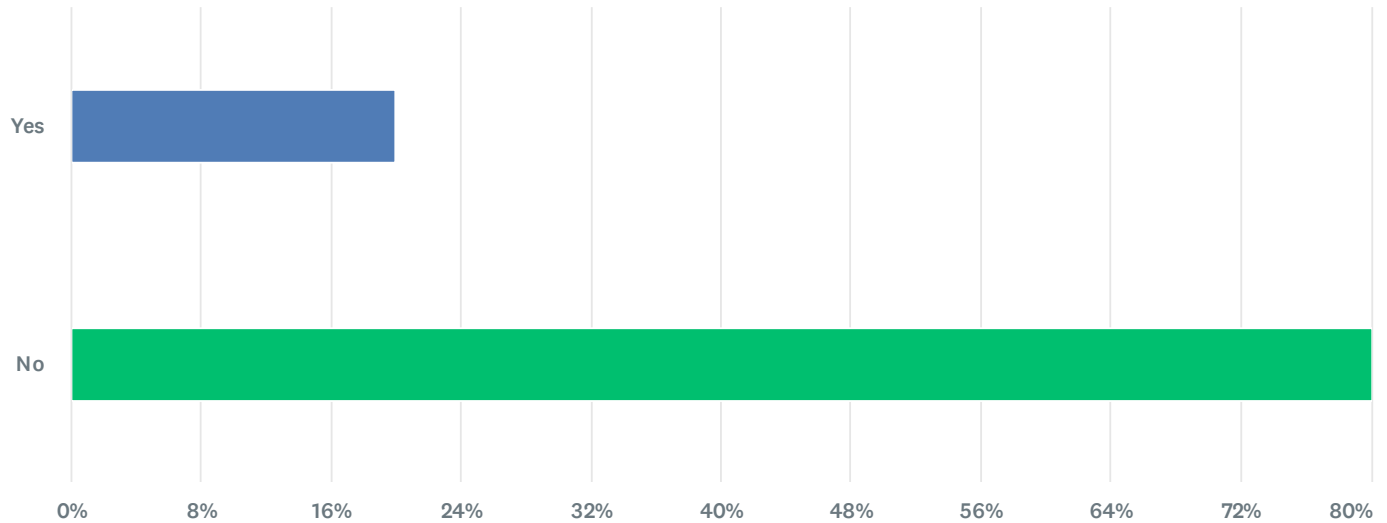
Would you accept a flashing sign that collects data on speeding, takes photo of license plate so that violation letters can be sent to owners with the potential for issuing fines?

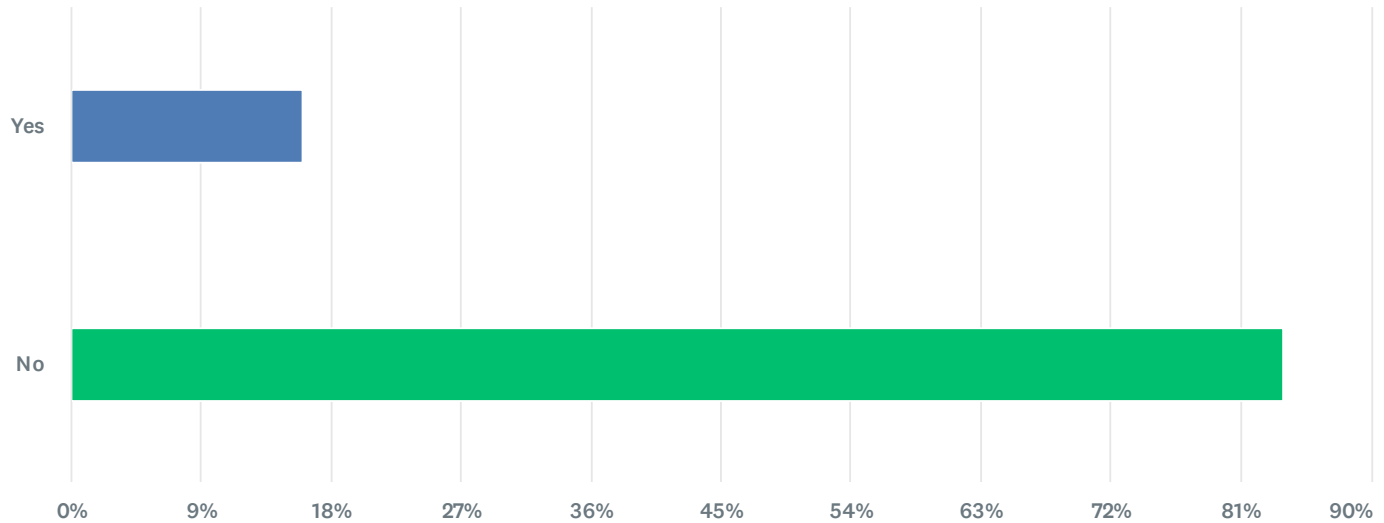
Do you reject any attempt to curtail speeding in the community even though it is a safety issue and mandatory for the Homeowners Association to solve?

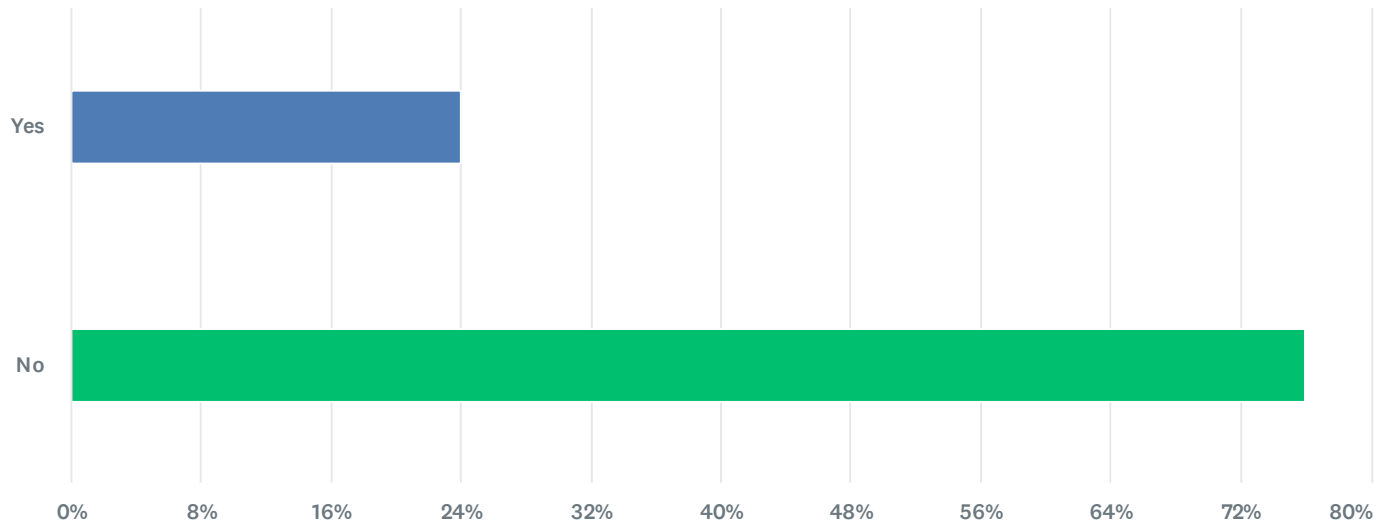
Would you accept removing the first speed bump on Bellezza Drive and moving it further down on Bellezza Dr. closer to the intersection of Fontana Estates Drive?

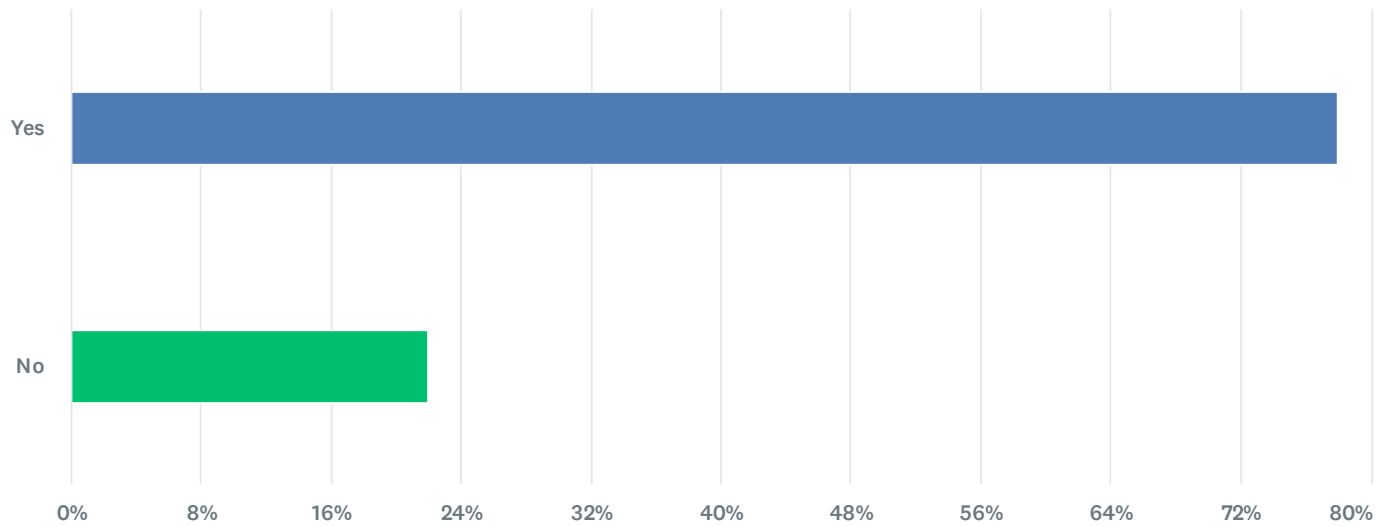
