# Regulations

# 1. Categories

- Solos (time limit of 4 minutes)
  - Junior School Group A (Year 1–3)
  - Junior School Group B (Year 4–6)
  - Senior School Group A (Year 7–9)
  - Senior School Group B (Year 10–12)
  - Adult Group
- Ensembles (time limit of 6 minutes)
  - Ensemble formations of 2–10 members are acceptable (no age limit for ensembles).

#### 2. Awards

- First, second, third prizes, and honourable mentions will be awarded based on the performance of each category.
- First prize winners will receive gifts and certificates.
- Second, third and honourable mention recipients will receive certificates.
