Did you know that K-12 and public libraries are exempt from Georgia's obscenity laws? Yes, that means the obscene, pornographic, and sexually explicit books in our school libraries and public libraries are there legally. Shocking news, is it not?

Georgia is not the only state where this is occurring. Nationwide, sexually explicit, obscene, and pornographic material is being pushed in our K-12 schools and public libraries. We can no longer sit back and let our children be stripped of their childhood and emotional health. Pornography addiction is on the rise among minors. These materials are grooming our children for sex trafficking and pedophilia. We can fight the system one book at a time, but they are here to stay until we change the existing GA Code, i.e. GA law.

We do understand the importance of intellectual freedom and access to a wide range of materials for educational purposes. However, there should be a clear distinction between protecting freedom of information and exposing our children to explicit and age-inappropriate content.

The onslaught of sexually explicit, pornographic, and obscene materials will not stop until our legislator's close obscenity loopholes in GA Code (OCGA 16-12-104). SB 74 will remove the loophole in GA Code. SB 74 passed the Georgia Senate in 2025 but failed in the House Judiciary Non-Civil Committee. This bill is still active for the 2026 legislative session.
