

15 QUESTIONS TO ASK WHEN YOU ARE INTERVIEWING YOUR PARAMOTOR INSTRUCTOR

1. Is your school USPPA certified?
2. Does your school follow a syllabus
3. Besides training centered around flying, what else do you teach such as weather, motor maintenance, rules and regulations, sectional charts and airspace
4. What do you teach when the weather does not permit kiting of flying
5. Do you offer tandem flights in your training
6. Do you rent equipment for me to use while I am training
7. What type of accommodations do you provide for your students while training or are there hotels near by. Can I camp on the grounds and is there RV hook ups
8. Tell me about the area I am going to be training on. Is there other air traffic, electric wires, wide open manicured lawns, do you teach in the same place or do you move around to other fields.
9. Do you tow for landing practices
10. What other tools do you use to teach such as video analysis of the students
11. What is your goal for the number of flights your students will have before they complete their training with you?
12. Will you be able to help me in purchasing equipment that is a good fit for me. Is there a price break on my training if I purchase from you.
13. Once I am done with training what type of support will I have from you about flying as well as on the equipment I purchase from you.
14. What is the student to trainer ratio of your classes
15. Can you give me a few names of former students that I can call as a reference
