JEI 2018 JUNIOR PRO HIGH SCHOOL CHAMPIONSHIP – SCHOOL TOUR & GRAND FINAL

STRUCTURE

- 8 Schools will compete to win the title of **JEI 2018 Junior Pro High School Champion**
- Each School will be required to select 10 students to compete. The JEI recommends the selection process to be a vote, based on nominations, done by the student body.
- The JEI will host a qualifier at each school. 10 Students will compete in a double elimination format tournament in order to arrive at 1 champion who will represent their school in the Grand Final.
- Proposed school tour period (Oct 15th to Oct 31st)
- Proposed Grand Final Date (Nov 10th)
- Schools will be required to give three optional dates with a 4 hour time window to allow the JEI to execute the qualifier in the school auditorium (or other suitable area).
- As a part of the marketing process the JEI encourages each school to utilize social media to promote the tour and grand final.
- A list of all participating schools and sponsors will be prepared as soon as the application process has been completed.

TOURNAMENT RULES

Failure to adhere to the tournament rules may result in disqualification.

- All games will be played on the Playstation 4 (PS4) console and the format will be double elimination.
- **Game Settings:**
 - All games must be played in sunny / clear weather conditions.
 - **Difficulty Level:** Legendary
 - **User Defined AI Settings:** Default
 - **Game Speed:** Normal
 - **Referee:** Random
 - **Injuries:** On
 - **Offsides:** On
 - **Bookings:** On
 - **Handball:** Off
 - **Camera:** Tele

General Rules:

- The tournament is open to both male and female participants
- Tournament will be contested on PlayStation 4 systems running FIFA 2019.
- The maximum participants in this tournament will be 10 players, the winner will be chosen as the school's representative at the Grand Final event (TBA). If the winner is unable to attend the final event the player placed immediately below may be chosen to represent the school in his/her place.
- Controllers will be provided on site for competitors to play with at the gaming stations. Players may bring their own controllers to use if they feel more comfortable.
- A player has 3 minutes to show-up at the gaming station once their name has been announced for a match. Failure to do so will result in a forfeit.
- Players must advise the tournament organizer (T.O.) if they are going to be missing from the playing area for an extended period, permission to do so will be at the T.O's discretion.
- Matches will be overseen by individual T.O. who will record the outcome of the matches in the bracket.
- The JEI has a zero tolerance policy for cheating. Players caught cheating, "glitching", colluding or abusing in-game mechanics in any way will be disqualified from the tournament.
- Competitors will conduct themselves in a friendly and respectful manner before and after matches to ensure the spirit of competition is represented appropriately.

Tournament Rules:

- Players are allotted 2 minutes at the start of the match after selecting their team to organize their team's offensive and defensive formations as well as their controller settings before the match starts.
- All matches will be 4 minute halves; winners, losers and grand final matches will be 5 minute halves.
- Players are allowed 4 Pauses per match, lasting no more than 30 seconds for substitutions. Players can only pause the game if the ball is in their possession, the player has been injured and they have possession or the ball is currently out of bounds.
- Matches will all be decided in a penalty shootout if match ends in a draw.
- INTERNATIONAL/CLASSIC/WORLD XI Teams are not allowed.
- Tournament is run in a Double Elimination style bracket format. Supervision will be done by a **JEI** representative. All tournament issues should be directed to the T.O. and will be addressed accordingly.
- All decisions made by the **JEI** representative (T.O.) are final and must be adhered to by all competitors.
- The **Jamaica eSports Initiative** retains all rights to change and amend rules as necessary on a case by case basis. Any changes or modifications will be communicated to all participating competitors.
