For the fourth year in a row the festival will be held on the grounds of The Slovenian National Home located at 2717 West 10th Street in Haughville with its newly remodeled event hall, outdoor seating and ample parking. Special precautions will be made to assure your safety! The doors will be opening at 2pm and closing at 8pm. Slovenian food and drinks will be accompanied by the sounds of polka from Indy Polkamotion. There will be vendors, raffle and plenty of fun activities for young and young at heart!

Haughville? Haughville has been the historic epicenter of Slovene community in Indianapolis since the 1880s. With its location in the heart of the Haughville Historic District, the Slovenian National Home (SNH) remains a pillar of the Slovenian community for over 100 years. It is crucial to keep this tradition alive as this neighborhood, located minutes from downtown, experiences urban renewal.

Newly remodeled events hall! After successfully replacing the roof we performed a substantial remodel of the event hall; original ceiling was restored, walls and lighting upgraded, and bathrooms completely remodeled. These and many other upgrades make our hall a great location for hosting your next event.

Potica

(Slovenian walnut roll) is a traditional festive pastry from Slovenia.

Potica consists of a rolled pastry made of leavened paper-thin dough filled with any of a great variety of fillings, but most often with walnut filling.

Potica will be baked by our dedicated "Potica Team" of Slovenian National Home and served at our 2022 Slovenski Festival.

Our Indianapolis version of Kranjska Klobasa will be prepared fresh at the Slovenian National Home and served with sauerkraut at the 2022 Slovenski Festival.

2021 Slovenski Festival lead to a successful grant application from Ministry for Slovenians Abroad

Last year's Slovenski Festival was attended by the highest representatives of Republic of Slovenia in the US, including Ambassador Kajzer, and Consul General Jerak. This initial visit was followed by special visit by Minister for Slovenians Abroad Dr. Jaklitsch and Secretary Žigon. The Slovenian representatives were impressed by the quality of our events, by our vitality of our organization and by the extent of our activities. They encouraged our application for a grant from Slovenian government in support of our remodeling effort. We are pleased to report that the Slovenian National Home (SNH) received a grant of EU 33,000 from the government of Republic of Slovenia. The positive impression, which was earned with your efforts, was crucial for the success of our grant application!

The remodeling of the main hall of SNH is in progress, with substantial portion, including remodeling of bathrooms, ceiling, walls and lighting. already completed. Please come and see the progress in person during our 2022 Slovenski Festival.

Completion of the Remodel of Main Event Hall

Sound structure of our building on 10th Street is crucial for continuous operation of The Slovenian National Home. Our ancestors put great effort in constructing a building of highest quality, however after 80 years of operation the building requires substantial work.



We intend to continue the remodel initiated two years ago and has already resulted in new roof, restored ceiling and bathrooms and new lighting. The goal of this festival and associated funding drive is to raise \$30,000 toward the remodeling of the stage, the bar area and the windows of the events hall (upper level).
