Highland Middle School Choir Guidelines for Membership

- 1. Individual actions are a reflection of the entire choir. Students must conduct themselves in a manner worthy of membership. This includes following school rules and maintaining passing grades in all courses.
- 2. An orderly environment is necessary to achieve a high performance level; therefore, proper behavior is required at all rehearsals and events. Please follow these guidelines:
- a. Be in your seat and ready to learn (with music and pencil) at the beginning of class.
- b. At the start of class, sit quietly and complete any assigned bellwork while attendance is taken.
 - c. Food, drinks, or gum are not allowed.
- d. When the director or another student is speaking, all students are to be quiet and attentive. Disruptive noises, talking or actions are not permitted during class.
- 3. Class Supplies: Students will need a black binder for select concerts/performances. Students need to bring their music and a pencil to class everyday.
- 4. Students are encouraged to take music home to practice. Music may also be kept in the folder cabinet in the choir room. Place your choir folder/binder in the slot that matches your assigned seat number.
- 5. **Attendance at all performances is required.** Performances are the equivalent of an exam for this course. If a student has an unavoidable conflict, his or her parent/guardian should notify Mrs. Wesselmann by email or in writing as soon as possible before the performance. A written request for absence does not necessarily constitute being excused from the performance. Unexcused absences from performances can result in a lower grade and/or students not being allowed to attend special events.
- 6. Students should demonstrate proper care for music and our facility. Music will be collected at the end of the year. Any damaged or lost music will result in a \$3 fee to replace each piece of missing music.
- 7. Students should be musically prepared for each rehearsal, having practiced assigned music and completed any written assignments. Bring a pencil to class every day.
- 8. Students will be graded on the average of daily rehearsal participation (50%), individual assignments (15%), and performance attendance (35%).
- 9. Concert Attire: Choir attire for choir is black and white dress clothes.
