Dear Hiawatha Manor Owners,

We are pleased to inform you that Hiawatha East will be re-opening on October 28th after the temporary closure. We appreciate your patience and understanding during this time, and we are excited to welcome you back to enjoy the resort's amenities.

As shared previously, the temporary closure was necessary due to staffing circumstances beyond our control, but we are happy to report that we have made the necessary adjustments. We have worked hard to maintain the resort's operations and ensure that all services will be fully available upon reopening.

What to Expect:

1. New onsite office at Hiawatha East that will facilitate all check ins.
2. Reservation Procedures: The resort is ready to handle reservation requests for Hiawatha East, or for deposits to one of our exchange partners. All owners should be current on maintenance fees if they are requesting to reserve their ownership week or to make a deposit with an exchange partner. Hiawatha East is not currently collecting 2025 maintenance fees, and as a result will not be making reservations for 2025 or allowing deposits into exchange companies for 2025 intervals at this time. If you currently have a deposit with an exchange company, there is no impact to your deposit. For RCI Points members, RCI points for your current use year should be available to you with no disruption.
3. Retention of POA amenities including the new indoor pool. Hiawatha West (including the Health Spa) still remains closed.
