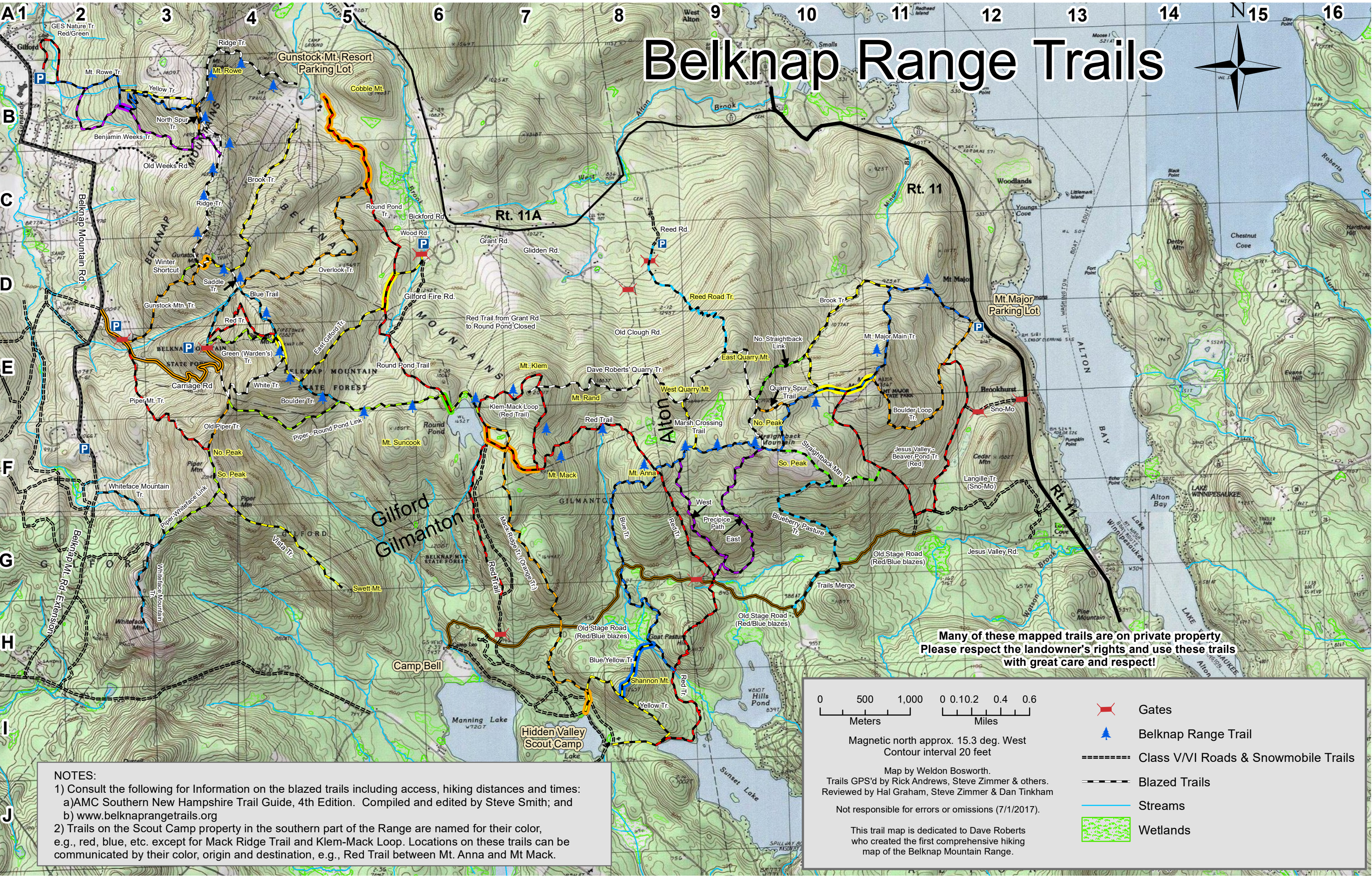


Belknap Range Trails
