Eighty-five percent of Blackburn students make ends meet by taking advantage of this liberal arts school's work program, though tuition and room and board at Blackburn College may be supplemented by standard sources of financial aid. Students in this program must log 160 hours of work per semester, earning tuition credits as they work on campus or in the nearby southern Illinois community. Blackburn's Work Program is unique in that it is managed by its students, providing participants the opportunity to gain higher-level skills that may be more attractive to employers.

A private Christian school, has a student population of less than 200. Each of the seven available degree programs is taught from a Biblical perspective. Every student at Ecclesia is eligible for financial aid through the school's Work Learning program. Participants spend 15 hours per week in positions on campus; junior and senior students are placed in jobs that align with their field of study. Tuition credits of up to \$2,000 per semester may be earned to defray the cost of attendance.

The school offers a scholarship that greatly discounts the cost of online enrollment.

All residential students must work at least 80 hours per semester; in return, a minimum of \$1,650 may be credited against tuition. Total enrollment is about 100 students and average class size is seven. At 63%, Sterling's first-year retention rate is higher than most colleges.

#### 28. Grinnell College:

In Iowa, is one of three private colleges where 20 percent of students use a Pell Grant. The school, which has a large endowment, is "need blind" in admissions, meaning that it doesn't take financial considerations into account when admitting students. It also

pledges to meet the full financial need of students with grants and a relatively small amount of federal loan debt.

In addition, Grinnell specifically seeks out low-income, high-achieving students with the help of several nonprofits.

## 29. Macaulay Honors College at City University of New York:

All students at Macaulay Honors College receive a full, undergraduate, free-tuition scholarship (not including fees). They also receive a \$7,500 Opportunities Fund grant for global research and study service/learning opportunities, a MacBook Pro laptop computer and a Cultural Passport to New York City arts and cultural events. Housing support is also available. Students are required to meet CUNY residency requirements for in-state tuition in order to receive the full-tuition scholarship.

Established in 2001, Macaulay Honors College, located in New York City, is a liberal arts college combining traditional and experiential teaching and learning. The school has tripled its enrollment since its beginning to about 1400 students.

Students have the option to enroll in one of eight CUNY colleges through the Advising Program and each student creates an individualized academic program which includes courses selected from more than 210 majors.

#### 30. Williamson Free School of Mechanical Trades:

Williamson Free School of Mechanical Trades is the only trade college in the United States which gives all students full scholarships to cover textbooks, tuition and room and board.

Founded in 1888, Williamson Free School of Mechanical Trades is a three-year, men's only junior trade school located in Media, Pennsylvania. Most students come from the Southeastern and Central Pennsylvania regions.

The school has a living environment based on the Judeo-Christian perspective which fosters the values of faith, integrity, diligence, excellence, and service.

The school offers programs to students in carpentry, masonry, horticulture, landscaping, turf management, machine tools, painting, and power plant technology. Upon graduation, students receive an associate's degree unless they decide to obtain a lower diploma in carpentry or masonry.

#### 31. Cornell University

Parents with a combined income of less than \$60,000 and assets totaling less than \$100,000 pay nothing for their child's education. Students contribute money from a summer job and a small amount of money from savings. The total estimated cost of attending Cornell University for one year is \$59k which includes tuition, student activity fees, housing, dining, books and supplies, personal expenses, and travel expenses. The university doesn't have a minimum or maximum amount of grant awarded. Income, family size, and assets, as well as the number of children in college, are all factors for calculating the amount a family is required to contribute and Cornell University doesn't have a standard "income bracket" or ceiling for grant-aid recipients; rather, eligibility is determined on a case-by-case basis.

Established in 1865, Cornell University is a private research university located in Ithaca, New York. As a private university and a land-grant institution of New York State, Cornell University is the most educationally diverse member of the Ivy League. The university has seven undergraduate and seven graduate divisions at its main Ithaca campus. The school's research covers a wide array of subjects.

The university has over 29,000 students from all 50 states and 122 countries.

Families with a determined income less than \$60k don't have to make a contribution to their child's education. The estimated total cost of attending Duke University for one year is \$59k which includes tuition, fees, room and board, books, and personal expenses. The average approximate aid awarded to the class of 2014 for families with different annual income levels:

• \$60–79.9K: \$48,000 • \$80–100K: \$41,000 • \$100–120K: \$40,000 • \$120K+: \$19,000

First-year students are required to earn \$2,100, sophomores, \$2,400, juniors, \$2,500, and seniors, \$2,600. The Expected Family Contribution student portion is based on student's work during the summer to invest in their education.

Founded in 1838, a private, global research university located in Durham, North Carolina, has about 6,000 graduate and professional students, spread out among 10 schools and colleges.

#### 33. Princeton University:

In 2001, Princeton became the first university to offer every aid recipient a financial aid package to replaces loans with grant aid (scholarships) students do not need to repay. The average financial aid grant covers 100 percent of the tuition.

In order to receive this aid, students need to submit their family's information on the application, the university considers many financial factors. Princeton University does not use income cutoffs when determining whether to award financial aid. Approximately 60% of students receive need-based aid, with an average grant approaching \$40,000.

The estimated cost of attendance for 2014-15 is \$58,820 which includes a tuition rate of \$41,750, a room charge of \$7,500 and a board rate of \$6,045.

Established in 1746, Princeton University in Princeton, New Jersey is the fourth-oldest college in the United States. Princeton, an independent, nondenominational institution, provides undergraduate and graduate instruction in the humanities, social sciences, natural sciences and engineering.

#### 34. Vanderbilt University:

During the 2012 academic year, over 60% of undergraduate students received some type of financial assistance. Vanderbilt University meets 100% of a family's demonstrated financial need. Financial aid awards do not include loans; instead of offering loans to undergraduate students, Vanderbilt offers additional grant assistance.

Tuition and fees per year cost an estimated \$42k and the estimated total cost of attending Vanderbilt University is \$60k per academic year, which includes tuition, fees, room and board, and books.

The median award for families in the income range of \$0 to \$40,000 is \$59k and the awards range from \$31k to \$63k. The average financial aid package for first-year students entering the university in 2012, who received need-based assistance (including Vanderbilt funds) consisted of 97% gift aid and 3% work.

Founded in 1873, Vanderbilt University a private, research university, located in Nashville, Tennessee has about 12,000 students from all 50 states and from more than 90 foreign countries. Vanderbilt University, a member of the Association of American Universities, provides 70 undergraduate majors. The university's study abroad program includes opportunities in over 25 countries.

The school's tuition averages \$58,600 per year, which includes tuition, room and board, books, and personal expenses. Yale University meets 100% of demonstrated financial need and if a family earns a total gross income of 65k or less, they are not expected to pay for their child's tuition. The expected annual parent contribution is \$10,000; however, more than 10% of Yale University undergraduate families are expected to pay nothing for the education.

#### 36. Columbia University:

Parents with calculated incomes of less than \$60,000 and with typical assets are not expected to contribute any income or assets to tuition, room and board, or mandatory fees. No student qualifying for Columbia financial aid is expected to take out loans as part of his or her financial package.

Families with calculated incomes between \$60,000 and \$100,000 have a reduction in their parent contributions. The university has no official income ceiling for financial aid eligibility. It reports that many families with calculated incomes over \$100,00 receive financial aid packages.

Located in New York City, is a private, Ivy League research university.

The university has three undergraduate schools: Columbia College, the School of General Studies, and The Fu Foundation School of Engineering. Columbia also has a number of graduate and professional schools. The university offers more than 100 majors and concentrations. Columbia University is a founding member of the Association of American Universities.

Brown University has a 9% acceptance rate. SAT test scores (25th/75th percentile) are as follows: Critical reading: 630/740; math: 650/760; and writing: 640/750. The university has a first year 98% retention rate.

Families with total parent earnings of less than \$60,000 and assets of less than \$100,000 are not required to make a financial contribution to their child's education.

Undergraduate students with a total parent income of less than \$100,000 do not have a loan component in their award. Tuition is \$43,758 per year and the total direct and indirect costs are \$58,140.

Brown University meets 100% of a student's full, demonstrated need. Forty-six percent of the class of 2016 received need-based scholarships; the average need-based scholarship is \$40,209.

The student contribution from summer earnings is a standard contribution required for all students. An academic year work-study/campus employment expectation is part of the federal financial aid program.
