



JGR eSX Championship Rules

Rules / F.A.Q

1. If I miss qualifying can I still race?
 - a. The answer is no you can not compete in the events without a qualifying time
2. Can I sign up for both races?
 - a. No you may not sign up for the 250 Class and 450 Class
3. Can I change my class mid-season?
 - a. You are only allowed to switch classes ONCE and ONLY ONCE!
4. How long are the races?
 - a. All Mains will be set to Realistic Time
 - b. The Heats will be Medium Race Length
 - c. The LCQ will be set to the Short Race Time
5. Which tracks are going to be raced?
 - a. We will have more tracks than needed on a wheel that will be spun an hour prior to racing each night of racing

Series Info & Rules

1. Classes
 - a. 250 Class
 - b. 450 Class
2. Protests/Reviews
 - a. Each protest will be reviewed by an admin, depending on the view the rider will or will not be penalized
 - b. Any immature protest will be disregarded!
3. Rule Changes
 - a. The Admins are allowed to change the rules at any time so always be on the lookout
4. No Shows
 - a. If you signed up, but can no longer make it you must message an admin!
 - b. If you do this consistently without messaging an admin you will be looked over in registration!
 - c. Consistent Rage Quits will also give out suspensions!

Race Rules & Rider Etiquette

1. Lag-outs
 - a. If a rider lags out before the gate drops we will issue a restart
 - b. If a rider lags out after the gate drops we will only restart if it's within the first **2 MINUTES FROM THE START OF THE RACE!!!**
 - c. If anyone lags out after the first 2 Minutes (Even 1 Second after) it will be treated as a mechanical failure!
Ex. Time Remaining in A Main is 18:01 it will be restarted... If the Time Remaining is 17:59 no restart
2. Aggressive/Dirty Racing
 - a. There is a difference between aggressive and dirty
 - b. Keep the dirty racing for the public lobbies and the lobbies with your friends!
 - c. Race hard and clean, aggressive block passing is allowed, but just know the limit please!
 - d. You can and will be suspended and/or banned if needed
3. In-Race Warnings
 - a. If you receive 2 QUICK warnings that means you are about to be lapped, you need to hold your line on one side of the track and allow the leaders to pass
 - b. If you receive a SINGLE warning that means you made a pass that was a Take-Out or an overly aggressive move!
4. Cutting Track
 - a. If a rider is caught cutting track and/or taking a cheater line they will be punished to the fullest extent!

8:20 PM US EST - 250 Heat 1 & 2 (10 Minutes + 1 Lap) (Both Heats will race at the same time) Top 5 advance to the A Main, 6th-11th to LCQ, 12th to B Main

8:35 PM US EST - 450 Heat 1 & 2 (10 Minutes + 1 Lap)(Both Heats will race at the same time) Top 5 advance to the A Main, 6th-11th to LCQ, 12th to B Main

8:50 PM US EST - 250 & 450 LCQ (5 Minutes + 1 Lap) Top 2 Finishers advance, the rest to B Main

9:00 PM US EST - 250 A-Main Event (15 Minutes + 1 Lap)
B Main will be ran at the same time

9:30 PM US EST - 450 A-Main Event (20 Minutes + 1 Lap)
B Main will be ran at the same time

If we have 24 Sign-Ups or less

8:00 PM US EST - 250 Heat 1 & 2 (10 Minutes + 1 Lap) (Both Heats will race at the same time) Top 5 advance to the A Main, 6th-11th to LCQ, 12th to B Main

8:15 PM US EST - 450 Heat 1 & 2 (10 Minutes + 1 Lap)(Both Heats will race at the same time) Top 5 advance to the A Main, 6th-11th to LCQ, 12th to B Main

8:30 PM US EST - 250 & 450 LCQ (5 Minutes + 1 Lap) Top 2 Finishers advance, the rest to B Main

8:40 PM US EST - 250 A-Main Event (15 Minutes + 1 Lap)
B Main will be ran at the same time

9:10 PM US EST - 450 A-Main Event (20 Minutes + 1 Lap)
B Main will be ran at the same time

Class Eligibility

- 250 Class
 - In order to run our 250 Class you must have never finished in the Top 3 of a Championship in your SX League Racing Career, no matter the series
 - If you have ran our GP series in the 450 Class and finished Top 5 in Points it is REQUIRED you race 450's in SX as well
- 450 Class
 - Our 450 Class is open to anyone
- Switching Classes
 - You are allowed to switch what class you are competing in mid season
 - You can only switch your class once per season
 - Your points will not carry over if you decide to switch your class
