10th edition January 10, 2023, BBRS meeting

The 10th edition is scheduled to be on the next Building Code Coordinating Council meeting January 26, 2023 agenda <u>linked here</u>.

Once the BCCC process is completed the draft <u>linked here</u>, then goes the State Office of Accounting and Finance (A&F) for review and action. The period of time at A&F is unknow, with the change in Governor and Ms. Healey's appointments to various offices will affect the timeline. Once A&F release the document the BBRS then can set a date for public hearing on the proposed code consistent with the notice requirements for public hearings.

Following the BBRS public hearing, the custom had been to have a period for additional public comment, a review of that comment followed by adoption of changes, then a vote to promulgate. The code then needs to be sent to the Secretary of State's Office for publication. Included in the draft language is a concurrency period with date to be determined after the BBRS public hearing.
