General Roofing Replacement Guidelines:

- Water stains on ceilings or walls may indicate a roofing leak.
- Long-standing leaks may require mold remediation.
- Act quickly if a roofing leak is suspected.
- Untreated moss can cause roof and structural damage.
- Rotted or water-damaged materials (wood sheeting, decking, gables, joists, fascia, soffits, gutters) may need attention during roof repairs or replacement.
- Roof replacement is a good opportunity to upgrade attic insulation.
- Consider future plans for solar panels, as certain roof types may be required.
- Adding a second layer of composite roofing can save thousands compared to full replacement.
- Metal roofing is ideal for homes with excess plant debris.
- Explore composite shingle reconditioning as an option.
