Step 1: Understand Your School's Unique Needs

✓ *Know Your Boundaries*

First, check with your school district and principal to understand which types of fundraisers are allowed. Some districts in Florida prohibit physical events like Color Runs due to liability concerns, while others encourage them for community building. You'll also want to make sure your principal is on board with any fundraising plans and that your chosen fundraiser aligns with school policies and schedules.

✓ *Avoid Conflicts with Testing & Events*

Many schools make the mistake of launching fundraisers during state testing weeks or immediately before holiday breaks. Avoid these windows. For example, our Holiday Shoppe is best run in early December before winter break, while Fall Catalogs like Winter Wonderland should be run from late September through early November. Spring fundraisers such as Colorathons are great post-testing morale boosters.

✓ *The 3-to-1 Rule*

Balance is essential. For every one fundraising event you host, aim to run at least three non-fundraising community-building activities. Events like Family Reading Night, STEM Night, or Teacher Appreciation Day help maintain positive engagement with your school community, so families don't feel like they're constantly being asked to give money.

Step 2: Create a Year-Long Fundraising Calendar

One of the most effective ways to ensure your PTA or PTO reaches its goals is to build a comprehensive fundraising calendar for the entire school year. This allows you to plan ahead, recruit volunteers, and avoid burnout. Here's a suggested model many successful Florida schools follow:
