RULES & REGULATIONS



Tournament Rules & Information

This tournament is a non-sanctioned, handicap competition consisting of three standard games bowled on a single pair of lanes. Standard 2026/2027 USBC regulations govern any circumstances not explicitly detailed in these rules.

Eligibility & Averages

Youth Bowlers: Youth participants must hold active USBC sanctioning to be eligible for competition.

Handicap Formula: Handicap is calculated at 90% of 220, based on the bowler's highest 2025/2026 book average.

Unassigned Averages: Participants without an established book average will enter with an assigned average of 150 for male bowlers or 130 for female bowlers. All averages remain subject to adjustment by the tournament director.

Attire Policy & Code of Conduct

Encouraged Attire: Participants are strongly encouraged to wear military-themed hats and shirts.

Prohibited Attire: Clothing featuring obscene or vulgar imagery or language is strictly prohibited. Tank tops are not permitted. Skirts, skorts, and shorts must extend past the bowler's fingertips. Ripped, torn, or soiled apparel is not allowed.

Behavioral Standards: Inappropriate conversations and profane language will not be tolerated.

Fee Structure & Distribution

Registration fees are \$40.00 for Adult participants and \$20.00 for Youth participants, with an additional \$10.00 fee applied to late or walk-in registrations. Entry fees are allocated as follows:

Lineage & Administrative Expenses: \$12.00

Divisional Awards: \$13.00

BVL Contribution: \$15.00
