### 2019-2020 CENTRAL ARIZONA USBC OPEN TOURNAMENT RULES

### PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Tournaments will be bowled in strict accordance with these rules.

1) All entrants must be a member of the Central Arizona USBC Association (CAUSBC) and of USBC. Entrants must use their highest 2018-2019 Winter Yearbook average of 21 games or more, posted on Bowl.com. If bowler does not have a Yearbook average they will use their highest current average at the time, they must have bowled 21 or more games. If neither option is applicable, bowler must use an average of 230. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to determine that the submitted average is correct. Failure to use proper average shall disqualify scores, if the submitted average is lower than the actual average. Bowlers may change their submitted average, if necessary, anytime before they bowl. USBC Rule 319c, Average Adjustments (Rerating), shall apply. If a bowler's current average is 10 pins higher than prior year's average bowler must use current average.

2) USBC sanction cards shall be shown at time of check-in.

- 3) Entry fees will not be refunded once the squad times have been posted. Changes may be made (substitutes) at the tournament site as late as squad check-in time.
- 4) 100% of prize money will be paid in the event in which it is collected. There will be at least one prize for each 6 entries in team, doubles and singles, and at least one prize for each 10 entries into All-Events.

5) This tournament is sanctioned by the United States Bowling Congress.

- 6) Handicap scores shall be eligible for cash prizes by division.
- 7) All handicaps shall be computed using the following formulas:

a) Team: 90% of 1150

b) Doubles: 90% of 460

c) Singles: 90% of 230

- 8) All Events and All Events Senior (Age 50+) are optional events and shall be awarded cash prizes on a handicapped basis. A bowler must pay the All Events fees in advance to bowling to be eligible for All Events Money.
- 9) All Events Scratch is an optional event and shall be awarded cash prizes on a scratch basis. A bowler must pay the All Events fees in advance of bowling to be eligible for All Events Money.
- 10) A bowler may enter this tournament more than once, if they chose to do so the following conditions shall apply:

a) A team line up must change at least 2 bowlers to be eligible for cash prizes.

b) A doubles pair will be allowed to cash only once in doubles. You can cash with a different partner.

c) A bowler can only cash once in singles.

d) The bowler's first appearance in each event will count toward all events and masters.

11) Lane assignment will be determined by the computer starting on Lane 1.

12) Bowlers are allowed one ball on the ball return at any time.

13) No electronic equipment shall be used while on the bowling approaches.

- 14) Division Break down is as follows: Team Regular is 876 and up, Team Standard is 776-875 and Team Classified is 775 and below. Doubles Regular is 351 and up, Doubles Standard is 311-350 and Doubles Classified is 310 and below. Singles Regular is 176 and up, Singles Standard is 156-175 and Singles Classified is 155 and below. These divisions are used to determine our scratch division winners for jackets and our handicap division cash prize winners.
- 15) Dress code: Participants will wear appropriate attire. Hemmed shorts, skorts, skirts, and jeans (with no holes) will be allowed. Note: Skirts, skorts and shorts must extend beyond bowlers fingertips when standing relaxed and arms extended downward at the bowlers side. Prohibited attire includes, but not limited to: Tank tops, cut offs, short shorts, headgear, sweats, spandex, workout clothes and shirts with inappropriate or vulgar picture or writing will not be allowed. A collared shirt or a bowling shirt is encouraged

16) Tournament Management shall decide and rule on any and all questions not covered by these tournament rules. The board's decision shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.

17) Anything not covered in these rules shall be covered under the USBC Playing Rules.

18) TEAM ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED TO THE WINNER OF THE EARLY BIRD DRAWING HELD THE OPENING DAY OF THE TOURNAMENT. TO BE ELIGIBLE A TEAM'S ENTRY FEE MUST BE POSTMARKED BY FEBRUARY 1st, 2020.
