	There were detailed Comments on the February 2024 Plan	
	submission by the Council, and most can easily be dealt	
	with, but matters relating to Site 21a, which cannot be	
	designated as a Green Open Space, and Anti-Social	
	Behaviour, needed further agreement, hence the calling of	
	an Open Meeting on 16 <sup>th</sup> April 2024 to agree our approach	
	with the Forum. PMR had suggested further environmental	
	policies for handling Site 21a issues which were raised at the	
	Open Forum meeting on 16 <sup>th</sup> April 2023. A further April 2024	
	version of the Plan had then been submitted to the Council	
	and they had now given the' green light' to go ahead with	
	the Regulation 14 Consultation, which is great news. The
