# ABOUT AMY SHANNON

Amy Shannon is an American Storyteller, living in upstate New York, where she grew up. She shares the stories in her head by putting them on paper (virtual or real), and most of her stories focus on the strength of women. Amy is Professional Book Reviewer, and her site Amy's Bookshelf Reviews is very popular among Indie Authors.

In 2004, Amy was a cancer survivor. In 2005, she survived a domestic violence assault, which resulted in her spouse going to prison, and lifelong migraine headaches.

Amy has four sons, who are very supportive of their family, and her passions. Amy went back to school in 2011, and since then has received her bachelor's in English, master's in Adult Education, and master's in business administration.

Amy has written over 140 novels, short stories, poetry, and nonfiction books. In 2024, she published her first nonfiction historical book, *Balls-Town: A Community of History, Friends, Neighbors, and Lingerin' Spirits*. She believes in preserving history, especially local history, and sharing stories of those who may not have been famous, but their lives were just as important.

Amy Shannon suffers from chronic daily migraines from her domestic violence assault. In the past two years, she had developed neurological movement disorders that include tremors that affect her hands and torso, leg spasms and muscle jerks, which affect her gait, sleep, and ability to be steady on her feet. She was recently diagnosed with Rheumatoid Arthritis, which provides her joints with constant pain. She still does work for authors, such as writing reviews, and creating promotions, as well as Literary Consultant Services.

Amy also is an advocate for disabled persons, especially the mobility impaired, and has her own YouTube Playlist Series for this issue.

# EXPOSED: MOBILITY IMPAIRED DENIED

## About:

## Primary Mission:

Abolish the Architectural Barriers Act (ABA) of 1968

Amend the American Disabilities Act (ADA) of 2010 to include Federal facilities and buildings have the same regulations for EASILY accessible entrances and exits. Amend ALL public access buildings have mandated automatic doors, or a button that can be pushed to make them automatic (light weight doors cannot accommodate everyone).

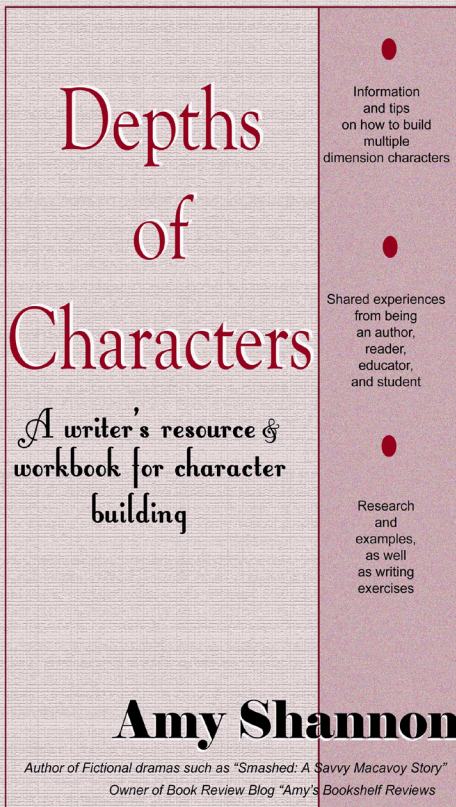
Amy Shannon is an author, Book Reviewer (Amy's Bookshelf Reviews) and host of the Amy's Bookshelf Reviews Podcast.

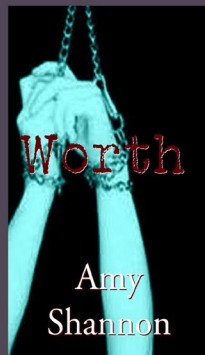
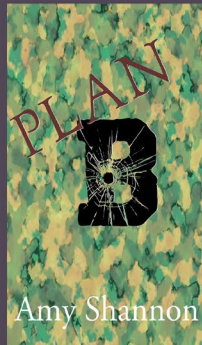
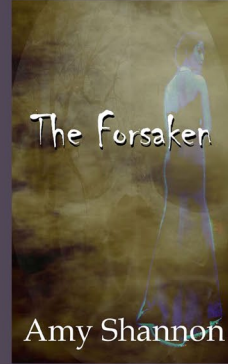
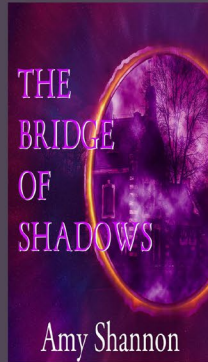
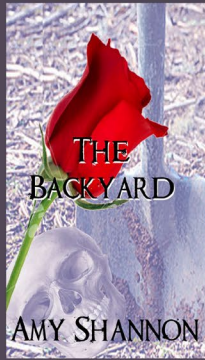
Most of her stories are fictional dramas featuring strong, female characters, though a few of her stories have a male protagonist and main character.

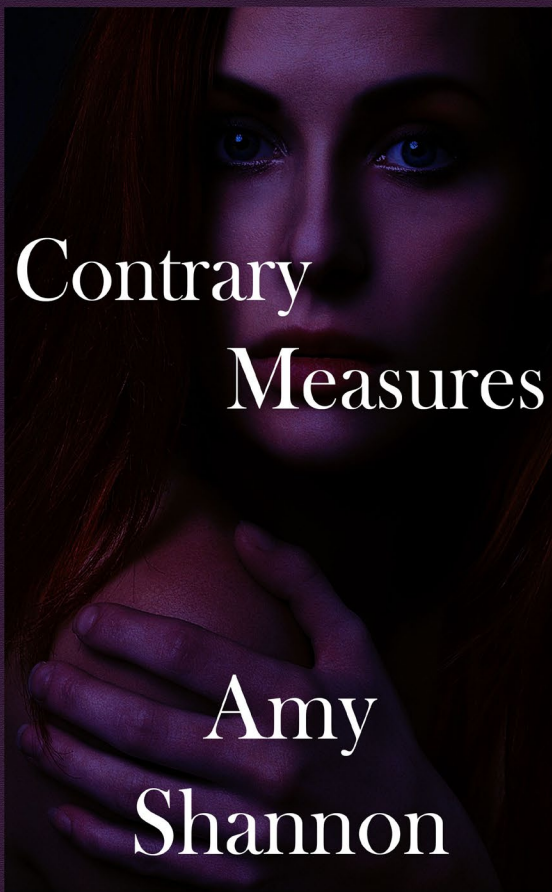
Suddenly, Link becomes entangled in a series of murders in his small town of Bridgeport. These crimes eerily mirror the plots of his books, including the one he's currently writing.

What is a Literary Consultant?

A literary consultant does many various Things for authors within the category of literary works or processes.

- Professional Editor. Content and copy editing, as well as Editorial Feedback.
- Reading (reads authors books to help them during the writing process). (This is while the book is still in the drafting or writing stage).
- Researcher. Amy will research for authors agents or publishers for the author, and come up with a list to help the author decide.
- Query letter writing, or assisting the author in drafting a query letter.
- Graphic Ads (creating ads similar to the ones in this portfolio)
- Literary Magazine (Literate-Ly Magazine, last issue in November to December 2025)
- Answering questions or just giving advice to authors.
- Helping authors with DIY publishing processes, including doing the actual process for the author.
