Podcast Schedule

Sundays at 6PM, 6:30PM (back-to-back episodes) or one-hour podcast appearance (Called a Spotlight Episode).

Amy's Bookshelf Reviews Podcast will add a 6:30 PM show on Sundays, following the 6:00 PM show.

However, if a guest would like to have a full-hour show, it will be a "special episode, that is 30 minutes long. These shows would not be on the second Sunday of the month (Amy's Storytime for All Ages) due to the new Segment, The Living Past.

A new segment called Literary Commentary will have Amy and a special monthly guest, author Talia Haven, discussing new trends, writing, and whatever else comes to mind. This segment airs the FIRST Sunday of the month. (January and February, this segment will run at 7:00PM due to scheduling, and starting in March, will go to its regular spot at 6:30 PM EST.

(If you want an hour, a small donation of your choice would be recommended). This is for new appearances that haven't been scheduled.

NEW: Participants now have the option of the doing an audio-only show, or having a video and audio show. When you book your appearance, it will ask which one you want.

Podcast Segments

Any episode can be one of the following segments of the show.

- Literary Professional Interviews (Authors, publishers, publicists or agent interviews)
- Your book discussion (paid by the author to promote their book on the show).
- Literary topics, news and trends
- Writing and publishing tips and recommendations
- Amy's Storytime for All Ages (every second Sunday of the Month) To promote reading children's books and literacy.
- NEW TO 2026: The Living Past resonant histories, because every life deserves to be heard (Second Episode of the Second Sunday of the Month) 6:30 PM EST.
- Full Hour Spotlight Episodes (donation greatly appreciated)

You can select audio-only or video and audio for the podcast, as Spotify allows for both types.

Use the <u>calendar</u> below to schedule your podcast prerecording. You will automatically get an email notification with the Google Meet instructions, and then a preparation email from <u>amysbookshelfreviews@gmail.com</u> (you don't need a Gmail address to use Google Meet). Using this, you will get an invitation on Google automatically and be reminded 24 hours and an hour before the meeting, if using this request.

If the availability on the calendar doesn't coincide with yours, email me and we'll work something out. I am very flexible and won't turn an author away.

Zoom or Google Voice Requests

Zoom is another prerecording option for audio use on your computer or smartphone.

Google Voice is a direct phone number you can call, and then the call will be recorded. This is for people who prefer talking over the phone to being on a video call (even words for landlines).

Want your book to be on the Show? (For this option, Email your request, as this would not require a booking.

\$10, your book can be on the podcast. (\$10 per book, per episode.)

The Interviews

- To be scheduled and prerecorded
- Donations greatly appreciated and accepted (see below).
- It's a conversation. You talk about your work and see where the conversation leads us. Sometimes it's more than just books!
- I do not have a list of questions that I ask. I ask a question, you answer, and we discuss.
- All I require is that when you get the link to your show, (you'll get it and the date the show will air after the recorded interview), is that you share the information with your audience, on your website and/or social media.
- All episodes of this podcast are prerecorded, and audio-only.
- The default program is Google Meet. However, I can use Zoom, or I can give you my Google Voice number, and record from there.
- Check your microphone on your computer to make sure it works.
- If using a cellphone, make sure you have plenty of charge on it.
- Also, I set the meetings to my time zone, Eastern. So, when we agree on a time, make sure I know if you are in a different time zone, and if you mean a time that is on your time zone, not mine.
- If your availability doesn't coincide with the booking schedule, email me and we will work out a schedule that works for you.

Rescheduling or Cancelations.

- If you need to reschedule, please let me know. When the recording schedule has started, I wait for 15 minutes for the author, and if the author does not contact me to reschedule, I will close the meeting and mark it as a no-show.
- Authors are allowed ONE no show and allowed to reschedule it.
