### What are vollebally club tryouts?

Volleyball club tryouts are events where players showcase their skills to coaches and evaluators in hopes of being selected for a club team. Tryouts typically involve various drills and exercises to assess a player's abilities in areas such as serving, passing, setting, hitting, and blocking. Coaches also look for qualities like teamwork, communication, and overall athleticism.

### Where are tryouts being held and when?

Bombers Volleyball 2025-26 tryouts are being held at The Den Sports Facility (House Hahl Rd, Cypress, TX). Ages 10 through 12 will tryout on July 1st starting at 6PM. Ages 13 through 15 will tryout on July 2nd at 6PM.

### What if I can't make the scheduled tryout dates?

Please contact us right away. We will still provide make-up opportunities or schedule a private tryout upon request. Please note that you may not be guaranteed your preferred position on a team after the regularly scheduled tryouts are completed. Scheduling in advance would be the preferred method to secure desired positions.

### Can your athlete tryout for multiple positions?

Your athlete can certainly try out for multiple positions! Please indicate which positions on the required forms that will be sent to you by e-mail after your pre-registration or at the time you walk-in for registration on the appropriate tryout date.

### Are all athletes guaranteed a spot on a team?

Unfortunately, BVC does not have the resources to accept all athletes who tryout; therefore, some athletes will not be offered a position on a team. Your athlete may be wait-listed and contacted at a later time should a position open up. I know this may not seem ideal, but we also want to put your athlete in the right position to succeed and find growth in the sport. BVC does offer alternative training options to build continued preparation for your athlete to have the support needed to meet their goals.

### When will we know if my athlete is selected for a team?

You will be informed immediately upon the conclusion of their regularly scheduled tryout. Please remember that not all athletes will make a club team. If you are offered a spot on a team we will require your immediate answer.

### How long do we have to decide if we accept the offer?

We will offer athletes who are selected for teams at the conclusion of the tryout session. We expect an answer before you leave our facility. If you accept you will need to complete all paperwork and submit your nonrefundable deposit. If you choose to decline the offer, we will immediately offer that spot to the next person. If you leave the facility without notifying us of your decision, we will offer that spot to the next person. We will not hold a spot.

## When will you know if your athlete has made a team after completing a private tryout?

If we are offering your athlete a spot, we will contact you by phone at the conclusion of her age group's regular tryout session. Please be ready to give us an immediate answer.

# My athlete wants to accept the offer! What are the next steps?

With that... Welcome to Bombers Volleyball Club Family!!

You will receive an email with a registration link to whichever email you used to register your athlete for the tryout. You will need to fill out all requested information and an invoice will be created for your subsequent monthly payments. Once the invoice is issued you can choose to pay in full and or set up Auto-Pay directly on the system.

We take your commitment to a team seriously; you are securing a spot specifically needed for that team and our organization will rely on your commitment, physically and financially, for the duration of the season.

### Do you offer payment plans or discounts?

Yes. We offer monthly payment plans and (3% off of the lowest sibling). Any discounts are applied to the amount remaining after the deposit and will be applied to your last installment

### What is included with your club fees?

All team fees include the cost of practices, tournament entries, facility usage and equipment, strength & endurance training (ATH), coach salary and travel, as well as a full uniform package.

### Will I have to pay anything extra?

All athletes must hold a membership with USA Volleyball and our governing Region. These memberships are released annually in the beginning of September and are paid directly to USAV and the Lone Star Region. The fee is about \$50.

If the team is participating in any tournament governed by AAU, a AAU membership must be purchased and the cost may vary around \$25

Athletes that are selected for a travel team will have additional travel costs. You will be responsible for travel, airfare and accommodations. These costs will vary for several factors including whether or not a tournament is utilizing a Stay to Play Policy.

Each team is required to have certified scorekeeper(s) and referee(s). Each certification is \$25 and good for two consecutive seasons. Your coach will let you know if this will be needed.

Note: All teams that will receive a bid to nationals or would like to participate in the Lone Star qualifier will vote on it. BVC intentionally kept these fees off your membership to reduce potential overspend and/or give the option to the players and families to decide. If your child is on a team that has a high probability of making a bid for nationals, we will furnish the appropriate cost schedule to set expectations.
