

She launched her career with a renowned fashion photographer, Kenneth Willardt, worked in house for brands like Giorgio Armani and Marc Jacobs and personally styled campaigns, editorials and some of the most influential women in New York City along side stylist Sarah Gore Reeves. Family always being paramount to Cinthia, she moved back to Brazil to raise her children while continuing to develop and launch up-and-coming Brazilian designers before embarking on her own brand. Cinthia currently resides in Miami with her husband, children, Luca and Vitoria, and their dogs Nico and Madalena.



Our sustainable practices.





Campo is a new brand, developed in 2019 and launched in 2020. Although new materials are used, and new products are created, we are dedicated to providing quality garments that are timeless in design and wear. You will never want to put on anything else to sleep. And you won't need to.

Ever mindful of a "slow fashion" sustainable design practice, Campo's fabric is ethically sourced, and all garments are consciously produced locally and in support of women artisans. We manufacture in small quantities and limit our distribution to an exclusive market. Our packaging is kept to a minimum and made of recycled and recyclable materials.

Recognizing the importance of the purest fabrics and organic products on our skin, our cotton is 100% Global Organic Textiles Standard (GOTS) Certified. Our fabric is dyed using natural, plant-based dyes or chemical-free dyes.

Our fabric deadstock is upcycled in the garments whenever possible. And we will maintain a commitment to sourcing only recycled, natural, or organic fabrics, always seeking to find innovative and beautiful pieces.

Our production has remained local, not only in support of the small factories and sample rooms that employ women in our community in Miami but also to reduce our carbon footprint. We consciously chose to avoid back-and-forth meetings and lessen the shipments across the country and overseas, which are disadvantageous to the environment and our mission.

Our commitment is to contribute to the sustainability of the fashion industry wherever possible, constantly update our customers with our initiatives, and provide beautiful garments that will last for many years.







Our buttons

We work with Corozo Buttons, the global frontrunner, producing bespoke, natural corozo (tagua) fashion buttons.

Corozo, or tagua, its indigenous name – grows most commonly in remote areas of higher elevation. The process required to gather and transform these seeds from their original form into raw material is relatively simple; however, it involves many steps that need low-skill labor. These steps include gathering, preparing, drying, peeling, cutting, turning, selecting, and transporting at the most basic level. These separate steps have an extensive multiplier effect as one job leads into another and then another, creating a domino-type effect. Over five hundred thousand pounds of seeds are required every month for the process; such required volume generates over one thousand full-time and part-time low-skill labor jobs in depressed and impoverished communities, jobs which help the community prosper and grow economically and increase the average quality of life.

Our fabric

We work with Ecological Textiles, a GOTS certified company. GOTS is the leading standard for organic textiles, and fabrics carrying the GOTS label represent the ultimate in ecological and sustainable production. It assures that the fibers from which the fabrics or other products are made were grown organically, without using insecticides or pesticides, using the most ecological and socially responsible methods throughout the production process. This means, amongst (many) other things:

- No GMO.
- No harmful chemicals.
- No child labor.
- No dyes or inks that have been classified as allergenic.





Our packaging

For the packaging of each product, we use certified home compostable poly bags made from completely biodegradable and compostable materials; corn starch, PLA (synthesized from corn), and PBAT (Polybutyrate Adipate Terephthalate). This combination of materials is non-toxic and contains no Phthalate or Bisphenol A (BPA).

They are certified free of GMO material.



Building on the existing collection, the sophomore season brings in cooler colors of a faraway paradise. Luxury pieces are mostly comprised of 100% GOTS certified organic cotton, including a limited edition quilted cotton. A 100% abaca fabric made from banana tree fibers is added to the group. Light and airy nightgowns, robes, kaftans, and pajama sets are still present, and an introduction to intimate pieces for both women and girls have been added, as has a lounge set for both men and boys.





says Boni Cordioli, 39, who's from Brazil and is now based in Miami. "Even if I have people over, I'm still in sleepwear. Everyone who knows me has seen me in a nightgown at home." Most high-end options, she says, were silk, and she wanted to create something more conducive to everyday living. Last year, she launched her company, which sells nightgowns, kaftans and robes, mostly in organic cotton, with feminine details like ruffles and bows.
