**Orient of Alabama Nomination and Evaluation Criteria
for
Grand Inspector General (GIG) of the Year**

Nominated GIG will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

1. Contributions to Scottish Rite Masonry at all levels (participation and involvement in the Consistory and Appendant Houses, Council of Deliberation, and Commanders of the Rite).
2. Offices held, service as the member of a committee, chairman of a committee or other positions in Scottish Rite Bodies.
3. Offices held, committee service as a member or chairman in all Prince Hall Masonic and Concordant/Affiliated Bodies.
4. Contributions to community and society in general (list service and positions held in church, businesses, civic associations, political, social services, etc.)
5. Awards and achievements (list any awards, letters, etc. received for community or fraternal service.
6. Personal goals and achievements accomplished and other noteworthy acts of service in the community.
