

Genoa Kingston Athletic Booster Club Scholarship

The Genoa Kingston Athletic Booster Club (GKABC) will award two \$1,000 scholarships to seniors graduating with the Class of 2026. One scholarship will be awarded to a boys' sport participant, and one to a girls' sport participant. Applicants will be selected based **on leadership, character, sportsmanship and school spirit**. School and community service, as well as academic achievements, may be considered.

These scholarships are available for any institution of higher education (community college, four-year college or university, or trade/technical school). Scholarship checks will be issued directly to the school. If you have already received a "full-ride" scholarship from your institution, you are not eligible to receive this award.

These awards will be presented at the Senior Awards Night on May 13, 2026. Please return the completed application and all the required attachments to the Guidance Office, attention Ms. Miranda, no later than the **end of the school day, Tuesday, April 7, 2026. No late or incomplete applications will be accepted – application must be complete and include letter of recommendation.**

Qualification criteria for the GK Athletic Booster Scholarship are:

- ✓ Must have at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.
- ✓ Must have participated in any sport for at least two years, including one varsity level sport during your senior year.

The applicant must submit the following documents which will be the basis for selection:

- ✓ Completed Scholarship Application (may attach additional papers to form).
- ✓ One letter of recommendation from a Coach or Assistant Coach.
- ✓ One-page essay (typed, no more than 250 words) explaining how your participation in GK Athletics has influenced your life and has helped you succeed in areas such as personal growth, leadership, mentoring, teamwork, responsibility, overcoming hardships, etc. Also discuss how you will utilize these life lessons in your future academic and professional careers.
