
FOREST CHUMP BIOGRAPHY

In 2025, Forest Chump — the musical identity of pianist, vocalist, songwriter, and fifth-generation Texan Ryan Lee Reid — was erased. Years of songs, videos, and online presence vanished overnight at the hands of someone he trusted. Living with schizoaffective disorder, and already a survivor of coercive control, psychiatric hospitalization, and relentless emotional sabotage, he had to start over from nothing.

What emerged was *The Birth of Forest Chump* — a six-volume, multi-genre body of work now in motion for **2027 Grammy consideration**. Across blues, jazz, country, folk, classical, americana, and electronic music, Chump's artistry is raw, Southern Gothic storytelling in its purest form: haunted by history, fueled by grief, and unflinchingly honest. From stripped-down cabin recordings with just a piano and one mic to lush studio sessions with Grammy-winning players, each volume tells a different chapter — survival blues, post-collapse originals, reinventions of jazz ballads, disco-laced anthems, Americana confessionals, and stormy classical works.

His voice carries ache and defiance in equal measure; his arrangements are minimalist but merciless. Every note is an act of resistance against erasure. Every song is proof that destruction can't kill a true voice. Forest Chump isn't just making music — he's writing his name back into history.
