 - Leadership within their high school and community
 - A strong work-ethic on and off the field
 - A commitment to living a drug free life while becoming the best version of themselves

- Submit Applicant Essay explaining goals, aspirations and embodiment of the important characteristics of being a successful collegiate athlete
- Provide one (1) character recommendation from an academic teacher
- Provide one (1) character recommendation from a coach
- Provide a list of applicants’ involvement in their school and community
