





Brad Manning




Brad Manning grew up in Hacienda Heights and he has always referred to it as his hometown. He attended Los Altos High School and then graduated from Cal Poly in Business Education. He became a high school teacher and coach and after teaching at several schools, he ended his teaching career at Workman High School here in the Hacienda La Puente Unified School District. Brad was the Head Football Coach for eleven years and eventually became their principal in 1996, after serving 3 years as an Assistant Principal at Wilson High School. He served as principal for seven years before moving to the district office. It was while he was an administrator, he joined the Hacienda Heights Kiwanis Club.

Prior to joining the Kiwanis Club, he coached Highlander Little League, Hacienda Heights Softball and Hacienda Heights Jr. All-American Programs. He was very active in Cub Scouts, PTA, St. John Vianney's Early California Days and chaired the district's Principal for A Day Program that invited community members to job shadow principals for a day and see what is happening on a daily basis in their school. Hacienda Heights is a great place to raise kids and attend schools and Brad is appreciative of that.

Brad grew up serving the community, following his parent's example. He remembers ringing the bell for the Salvation Army, helping with pancake breakfasts and spaghetti dinners during his father's fundraisers, and helping clean up streets making Hacienda Heights a better community. Brad continued community service by joining Kiwanis and eventually serving as President in 2000. Brad has chaired or served on many community service projects including the 4th of July Parade Committee for 20 years. During the pandemic, Brad chaired the re-envisioned parade as a Car Caravan that drove through the community the past two years during the pandemic. This was well received, and it kept the parade alive for the community during a tough time.

Brad loves this community and continues to volunteer his time with the parade, and for that the committee is thankful. He was named the parade Grand Marshal in 2020, but because of the pandemic, he will be honored today as one of three Grand Marshals.


back to West Palm Beach. Tom was stationed at Tyndall Air Force Base in Panama City Florida.



Tom and I came to North Whittier Heights (as the area was called) in 1956 to be two of 48 teachers at Puente HS. It was so beautiful. Pellissier Dairy had cows on the hills that would become Rio Hondo College. From our home we could ride our bikes to the top of the hill and see Catalina Island. There was no freeway, no Colima, only Hwy 39 or Turnbull Canyon to get over the hill to Whittier. To go to LA you took Valley Blvd or Washington Blvd.

We purchased our home on the G.I. bill in the Fireside Homes tract between Gale Ave and Clark. We could hear the train at night. Everything was so clear and green. Where Avocado Grove homes are today was a Christmas tree farm. We could actually pick and cut our own tree.



Once a member she was active serving or chairing committees with our Mini Grant Program, 4-way speech contest and our numerous scholarship awards.


In 1998 she became President of the club and had a very successful year. I believe, after serving as president she and Doris Hauser held down all of the clubs' Secretarial duties!
