# Pray for the Ilchamus Region!

Kenya is currently experiencing heavy rainfall, which has caused severe flooding in most parts of the country. Over 60,000 people have been displaced from their homes as a result. Due to the flooding, the Kenyan Government has postponed the reopening of schools until further notice, in the hope that water levels will recede soon.

In the Ilchamus region of Baringo,

over 300 people, including church leaders and congregants, have been evacuated to higher ground due to rising water levels according to reports by the Kenya Red Cross. Dixon Leleboo, the Ilchamus Regional Overseer and pastor in the GGFAN Loingewan church has informed us that his house is submerged in water, with water levels continuing to rise. The flash floods have left them unable to rescue their property, including livestock. Dixon's wife, Valentine, who is one of the Agricultural Regional experts, has also been affected by the floods. Her poultry project has been destroyed, and her chickens were carried away by the running water.

We kindly request your support in prayers and finances to help the families affected by the floods. These people require basic supplies such as food and bedding. May God bless you as you join us in offering a glimpse of hope to these dear ones!

# **HOTGS Healing Hearts Camp**

Forty-one children from the Home of the Good Shepherd (HOTGS) underwent a four-day healing hearts camp to help them heal their childhood trauma, find their courage, boost their confidence,

and regain their sense of worthiness. The camp sessions involved talks, play, and interactive learning activities designed to be fun and to help them feel safe and secure. Twelve girls and twenty-nine boys took part in the camp coached by thirty-two facilitators.

Trauma refers to a deep wound in the heart. Childhood trauma affects a child's self-esteem and confidence leading to a sense of shame and guilt. The child may show signs of bitterness, withdrawal, rebellion, anger, and aggression. The child may experience hurt, low self-esteem, frustrations, fear, confusion, and shame. The child cannot freely express himself/herself due to fear of victimization. This in turn affects their ability to socialize and relate with other peers which leads to poor performance in life and academics. Eventually, the unhealed trauma affects their family life at times leading to stress and depression.

# MISSIONS TO THE UNREACHED

## Making Samburu County Reached!

As of March 2024, the Samburu
County Nkalup Vision (SCNV) has
accomplished 70% of its goal of
making Samburu County reached
with the Gospel by establishing
1,000 churches and preaching points
in Samburu County. SCNV has

established 774 churches and preaching points of which 108 have built structures. Each church or preaching point is expected to disciple over 50 members who will be part of the disciple-making movements.

In March and April, preparation and verification processes are ongoing to build fifty-seven more churches. These processes are led by the SCNV coordinators

who also supervise and oversee evangelistic and disciple-making activities in the SCNV churches. Their efforts are made possible by the generous grants of our friends who heed the call to make the Gospel accessible to the unreached. We are grateful to God for His grace that propels our efforts; Samburu is changing from an unreached county to a least reached county.

# LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

## Staff Cross-Cultural Training

The GGFAN staff took part in cross-cultural training meant to give them deeper insight and understanding of the American culture. The training was conducted by Lisa Bailey, a

missionary with TMS Global. She trained the staff on the differences between the African culture and the American culture and how it affects behavior and performance. The main difference stemmed from the fact that Americans have a monochronic culture while Africans have a polychronic one. Monochronic people value schedules and are task-oriented while polychronic value interpersonal relationships.

Understanding the difference in culture is key to creating successful and impactful interactions between the GGFAN staff and the donors/partners. The training will help the staff have a better understanding of what to expect during their mission trips and communications.

We thank Lisa Bailey for her insightful staff training that helped to answer many questions and eliminate various stereotypes that they had about the American way of doing things!
