MISSIONS TO THE UNREACHED

SCNV Coordinator Motorbikes

Samburu County Nkalup Vision (SCNV) acquired eight new

motorbikes for use by twelve coordinators in Samburu. Samburu is a vast area that covers about 21,000 square kilometers. SCNV has established 869 churches in Samburu. Among the 869, 184 are self-sustaining mature churches and 685 churches are preaching points each under the leadership of a preaching point leader (PPL). Out of the 685 SCNV preaching point leaders, 90 leaders receive a stipend

every month, 204 leaders have started a preaching point with no stipend, and 391 leaders are off a stipend. Each preaching point leader ceases to receive a stipend (off-stipend) once his/her preaching point exceeds three years of existence. All the churches and preaching points are under the leadership of the twelve coordinators.

A New Academic Term!

In the eighteen Samburu County Nkalup Vision (SCNV) preschools, enrollment was high with over 1,176 children reporting to the schools by the second week after the opening. The schools resumed on 6th May after a six-week break. The official opening date for the schools was 30th April but it was pushed due to heavy rains that affected most of the schools and infrastructure in most parts of Kenya. Heavy rains destroyed some school buildings and flooded the schools' playgrounds.

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MERCY MINISTRY

Home of the Good Shepherd (HOTGS) has been changing the lives of vulnerable children since 2007. As of 2024, 139 children have been cared for, nurtured, and successfully reintegrated into society. Currently, we are taking care of 115 children who are of different ages and at different levels of education. We thank God for helping us to be among

the few institutions that holistically care for a child from the time he/she is rescued till he/she grows into a mature responsible adult. Most of our graduates are successful career people and entrepreneurs who have started their own families. John Maina Mugereki is among the 139 children who have been reintegrated and are doing well in life.

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GGFAN Regional Experts Training in May.

May 2024 Ag Report

The Agricultural Department thanks God for the great progress we are making in our farms, projects, and regional training. Our crops are growing well; some are ready for harvesting while others will be ready for harvesting in the next few months. Our twelve regional experts are working on their

projects, training, and co-ops; self-sustainability is the main goal. The experts attended a two-day training organized where they were trained on different topics to empower them.

Back to School!

The 282 Little Lambs
Academy students resumed
their studies after a six-week
break. The delay in the
opening of the school by the
Ministry of Education in

Kenya, due to the heavy floods that wreaked havoc in most parts of the country, led to an extension of the school holiday by two weeks. The floods destroyed classrooms while some classrooms and playgrounds became refuge centres for those displaced.

We are grateful to God that our school was not among those affected by the floods. Our students resumed their classes on May 13. The students are eager to continue their studies, especially after the opening delay.

Despite the delay in the opening of the schools, the Ministry of Education has not extended the academic term duration. This means the teachers must work extra hard to ensure they complete the syllabuses for the term.
