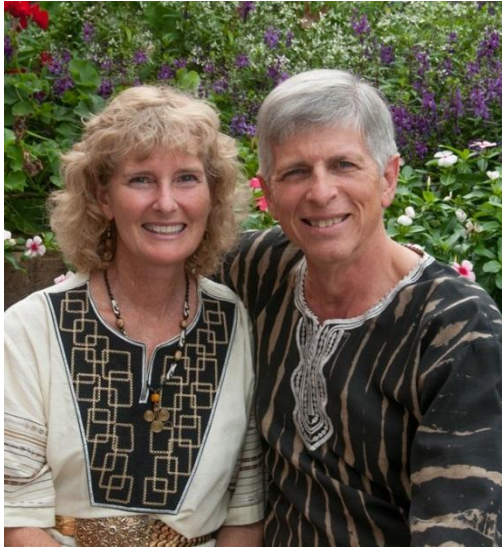


Jon and Julie Limmer

Jon and Julie Limmer, missionaries with Wycliffe Bible Translators, are assigned to JAARS, an



organization South of Charlotte in Waxhaw NC. They met at Wheaton College (IL) where Jon was graduated in Physics and Julie in Elementary Education with a minor in Music. Married over 40 years, they raised two children, and have two granddaughters. Jon spent six years in the US Navy before moving to New England where the family spent nearly 30 years in New Hampshire and Vermont. Before joining Wycliffe, Jon was the Director of Information Technology at a company in Middlebury, VT and Julie taught Music in a public school for 5 years and Kindergarten at a Christian school for 12 years.

It is the goal of Wycliffe to see the Bible translated into the heart languages of everyone who needs it. In 2005, Jon and Julie felt God's call to missions while attending

a JAARS "Missions at the Airport" event in Vermont. They realized that the skills they had acquired and were using in their respective fields could be immediately applied to support Bible translation. They joined Wycliffe in mid-2006 and began their first assignment in September of 2008 at the JAARS technical support center in Waxhaw, NC.

Jon's primary role is manager of the global email administration team supporting over 6,000 ministry members and partners worldwide. He also provides network and server Administration consultation services to Bible translation branch offices across the world.

Julie has been trained as a Vernacular Media Specialist. As such, she helps make the biblical message accessible through planning, recording and use of various media, such as video, audio, storytelling, drama and music—in local heart languages worldwide. At JAARS she is part of a team developing new media tools, options and strategies to equip language teams to make the biblical message clear and accessible.
