Sean and Rebecca, along with their daughters, Brooklyn, Madison, and Paige, serve in Palangkaraya, Kalimantan, Indonesia at a unique floatplane base serving river communities in the heart of Borneo. Sean serves as a pilot/mechanic and base manager while Rebecca homeschools all three girls.

The Cannons joined MAF in 2004 and served their first term in Latin America, living in Costa Rica, Ecuador, and Mexico. They moved back to their home state of Colorado at the end of 2008. A year later, they felt led to return to overseas missions and re-applied to MAF. They were assigned to Indonesia and moved to Java in 2010 for language study before arriving in Palangkaraya in 2011. Having lived in several different “lands,” the Cannons acknowledge that living in foreign countries can at times be overwhelming. “When we take the time to reflect on God’s faithfulness all these years, it becomes much easier to simply trust Him and do the work He’s called us to do. We feel honored to have experienced life in so many unique places and humbled that God would allow us to serve so many special people all over the world.”

As a pilot/mechanic, Sean has a unique opportunity to touch both the physical and spiritual needs of the people. He shares, “I get great satisfaction out of knowing that God can use my technical skills to bring the hope of Christ to hurting people.” In addition, he has been able to use his skills in leadership as the base manager in Palangkaraya.

Rebecca enjoys her role at home as she homeschools the girls and cares for the family. She has had opportunities to teach English to neighborhood children and develop relationships with the MAF national staff families, but focuses most of her time and energy on the full-time task of keeping their home running smoothly.

Sean was born and raised in Monte Vista, CO. While attending a church youth group in junior high, he recognized his need for

Christ and accepted Jesus as His Lord and Savior. During his teen years, he began to feel called to full-time ministry. It was on a visit to an MAF program in Ecuador during college that Sean first felt the call to mission aviation.

Sean holds an Associate of Science in Aviation Maintenance Technology from Eastern New Mexico University, in addition to a Commercial Pilot License and a Certified Flight Instructor Certificate with Instrument endorsement and an A&P mechanics license.

Rebecca also grew up in Monte Vista, CO, in a loving, Christian home and accepted Christ as her Savior at a young age. As a young girl, Rebecca dreamed of being a missionary, and went on several short-term mission trips during her high school years. The Lord used these experiences to further solidify her desire to serve in foreign missions. Rebecca holds a Bachelor of General Studies from Fort Hays State University. Sean and Rebecca met in their high school youth group and were married in 2000, with a common goal of preparing for, and then joining MAF.
