Scott was saved through the witness of a new Christian classmate, at the age of 14. Just before college, he worked at a Christian summer camp where he met Rachel, who was raised in a solid Christian home and saved at the age of 4. Their ministry has given them the privilege to work with and assist dozens of missionary families and Christians and church leaders from numerous people groups.
