



## Jason & Amy Miller

Jason was born in Missouri while his parents were in missions training with New Tribes Mission. He had the privilege of growing up in a Christian home and seeing what it meant to be involved first hand with tribal church planting. Jason spent the first 17 years of his life in Venezuela, South America. During that time the Lord really impressed on his life the need to be involved at a personal level. The thing that really made the biggest impression on him was the way aviation was used to speed the

Because of a need to move villages, Jason and his family hiked for three days through the jungle with the tribal folks carrying all of their belongings. The very next month the same trip was done in a mere 5 minutes using the airplane.

Jason graduated from the NTM high school, Robert Shaylor Academy, in 1989 and then attended Moody Bible Institute from 1989-1994. Jason graduated from Moody Aviation in the summer of 1994.

After working in the aviation industry for several years and watching the Lord pay off the education debt that both Jason and Amy had accumulated, they joined New Tribes Mission in the fall of 1999. They served in Venezuela as a pilot/ mechanic from the end of their training until coming home in 2008.

Jason and Amy now work in McNeal, AZ as a part of the flight operations and leadership teams. They have three children: Danielle and Carlyne are college students at Baylor University; Ezekiel will be a high school Junior in the upcoming 2013-14 school year.
