

**ABCs Bible Memory Challenge:** This week's ABCs Bible Memory Challenge verse is:

"Zion hears and rejoices" (Psalm 97:8). For more information about this "Memory Challenge" please see your September Newsletter for all the details.

Coffee Hour: Please join us for coffee hour in the Pumpelly Room following the 10:30AM service. All are welcome.

**Daylight Saving Time:** We "spring ahead" next Sunday, March 9th! Don't forget to set your clocks ahead the night before so that you are prompt for church services that morning.

**Teen Breakfast Club:** The Teen Breakfast Club will meet today to discuss "Pancakes, Palms, and Ashes: What's behind our Lent Traditions?" The club meets the first Sunday of each month from 9:30AM to 10:10AM in Mtr. Christina's office for food, a spiritual discussion, and prayer. All teens are welcome to attend.

**BURNING OF THE PALMS**: The congregation is invited to bring last year's blessed palms from Palm Sunday to church to be burned and turned into the blessed ashes that are distributed on Ash Wednesday. The palms will be burned at a short prayer service during the Shrove Tuesday gathering this year (children welcome!). A labeled basket will be placed in the Tower Chapel to collect palms until today, March 2nd.

**SHROVE TUESDAY:** Our annual Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper will be held this Tuesday, March 4th from 5PM to 6:30PM. Volunteers are needed to cook and should arrive by 4PM. Many other volunteers are needed for clean-up so that the Parish Hall can be ready by 7PM for the arrival of the men from the Overflow Shelter. **Ash Wednesday Services:** Please join us for Ash Wednesday services this Wednesday, March 5th. They are as follows: 12:05PM and 5:30PM both with imposition of ashes. The 12:05PM service will be a noontime service with liturgy and sermon and the 5:30PM service will be a Holy Communion service.

**CHORAL EVENSONG DURING LENT:** St. Peter's will offer Choral Evensong at 5:45PM on three Fridays during Lent: March 7th, March 21st and April 4th. Choral Evensong is the traditional sung version of Anglican Evening Prayer, sung in the English Cathedral tradition. The parish choir prepares a significant amount of choral music for these services, which provides for an especially beautiful and artistic form of worship.

**ANGELS IN TRAINING:** This month the Angels in Training will feed the hungry at Loaves & Fishes this Saturday, March 8th and again on Saturday, March 15th from 11AM to 1PM. Please consider helping for these 2 hours and give back to those less fortunate.

**Lent Small Group on Zoom:** Join us every Tuesday morning at 9:30AM on Zoom for a Lenten small group where we'll discuss the ins and outs of the classic Lenten practices: fasting (3/11), almsgiving (3/18), prayer (3/25), reading Scripture (4/1), meditating on Scripture (4/8), and encountering Christ in worship (4/15). **Friday Lent Early Morning Prayer on Zoom:** During the season of Lent, you're welcome to join us for Morning Prayer on Zoom each Friday at 6:30AM. This 20-minute prayer service from the Book of Common Prayer is a meditative way to observe Fridays in Lent as we draw near to the celebration of Jesus' Resurrection on Easter. **Adult Bible Study - Walking with Peter:** The second part of our study will take place on the first five Sundays in Lent beginning next Sunday, March 9th and continue through Sunday, April 6th.
