The Overflow Shelter at St. Peter's Church, in support of the Capital City Rescue Mission (CCRM), operates from November 4, 2024 to March 31, 2025.

This ecumenical effort is seeking volunteers for evening hours, 7:45PM until approximately 11PM; or overnight from 7:45PM until 6AM the following morning. Volunteers provide the ministry of hospitality engaging guests in conversation, playing board games, working puzzles, and assisting with healthy snacks from the kitchen. Come alone or team up with a friend or family member, acting as an extra pair of hands for the CCRM staff and providing a welcoming "home" environment to the guests.
