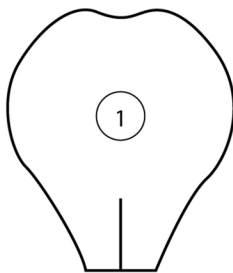
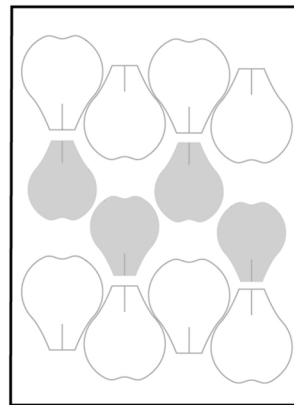


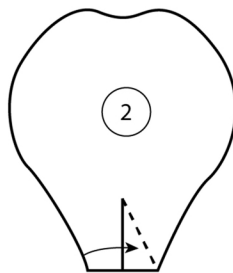
INSTRUCTIONS

MATERIALS:

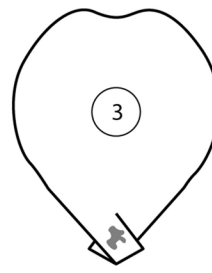
1. PAPER (CARDSTOCK PREFERRED)
2. SCISSORS / XACTO KNIFE
3. GLUE
4. PAINT (OPTIONAL)



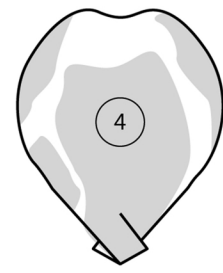
CUT



OVERLAP



GLUE



SCULPT

- 1 CUT ALONG THE DRAWN LINES ON THE CUT-OUT SHEET WITH A SCISSORS/XACTO KNIFE
- 2 OVERLAP THE BOTTOM TWO FLAPS. THE PETAL WILL BEGIN TO CUP ITSELF.
- 3 APPLY THE GLUE AND KEEP PRESSURE UNTIL THE GLUE FULLY CURES.
- 4 USE YOUR FINGERS TO SCULPT THE RIDGES OF YOUR PETALS. ROLL THE EDGES BACKWARDS FOR MAXIMUM BLOOMING EFFECT.
- 5 CONTINUE THIS PROCESS FOR EACH PETAL. GROUP AND GLUE THE PETALS ACCORDINGLY IN REFERENCE TO THE DRAWINGS BELOW.
- 6 STACK AND GLUE EACH GROUPINGS TOGETHER. ADJUST THE PETALS AS YOU GO TO GET THE BLOOMING EFFECT YOU DESIRE.
