On behalf of all of us, animal and human, we thank you immensely for caring.

2023 was a very different year from the previous ones, it brought the rescue many ups and downs, but mostly ups! We watched the rescue world become inundated with Covid dogs that were purchased by people from puppy mills and backyard breeders who thought getting a dog during covid was a good idea to combat the feeling of isolation only to regret their decision later when life got back to the way it used to be and time management meant giving up, abandoning and rehoming their dogs. This put a significant strain on all rescues and a challenge on the ability for all rescues to take in dogs that were needing rescue. We also saw a substantial decline in adoptions as people struggled with financial burdens brought on by the aftermath of Covid.

Within our rescue we were significantly impacted by the ability to recruit new fosters or convince seasoned fosters to take on more dogs because finally people could travel and do things that were restricted during covid. Unfortunately, we can only take in as many dogs as we have foster homes available. Luckily however, we still had a handful of our loyal fosters who always made room and time for incoming dogs and for that we are so very thankful.

We adopted out a little over 50 dogs in 2023. Financially, the rescue is sound, and we can continue operating into 2024 comfortably thanks to our donators' generosity and to the auction's success! As a rescue, we have been blessed with a fantastic rescue family; thank you to everyone who help us do what we do! Thank you to the tremendous volunteers, fosters, veterinarian clinics, board members and donors who have continued to support us in the endeavor of saving one dog at a time!

INTAKE


In 2023, we rescued 48 dogs.



They came from remote Northern communities including; Sandy Lake, Fort Severn, Keywaywin, Kasibonika, and Fort Hope. Since our dogs come through Thunder Bay, we are not always aware where they originated from before coming into rescue.

ADOPTIONS

We were fortunate enough to adopt out all 48 dogs to wonderful furever homes in 2023. With our thorough approach to adoptions, we are able to place these dogs to families who will love them and show them unconditional love. Occasionally, there are adoption placements that don't work out,



so these dogs come back into our care. We had 2 dogs returned to foster care in 2023. These 2 dogs have since gone on to new families. We also had one female dog come into rescue to care for her puppies, and then we had her spayed and returned to her owners in the community.

EVENTS & FUNDRAISING

In 2023, Southern Connection Dog Rescue attended multiple events to promote the rescue, engage our community, and increase adoption interest.


SCDR BOARD OF DIRECTORS

STACEY KENNY Adoption Team Lead



Team Lead for Adoption Team including screening all adoption applicants, vet references, rescue dog matching with appropriate applicants.

Responsibilities Include:

- Following up with new adopters.
- Back up support for other team leads.
- Attending/Organizing Rescue events.
- Transportation as needed
- Organizing the group of volunteer reference checkers.
- Following up with adopters regarding spay/neuter

TONIA TURPIN, Volunteer Team Lead

Team Lead for volunteers for the rescue from screening to coordinating volunteer requirements as they come up on a daily basis which includes special events, driving dogs to the vet appointments, moving supplies to foster homes, emergencies and transports.

Tonia is also in charge of our bi-annual auctions which brings in the majority of funds to our

rescue. She organizes sponsors, picking up and dropping off items, organizing the outlay of the online auction, coordinating as the auction is live, collecting funds, delivering and providing spreadsheets so that all monies are accounted for. Tonia also helps in all aspects of the rescue from tradeshows to transports and all special events.





DEVYN KELLY, Surrenders & Special Projects



Manages the surrender process for all dogs coming back to rescue or being surrendered directly to us by their owner. This includes everything from intake conversations, surrender paperwork, coordinating with the foster team, and support to foster and adoption teams while the dog is in rescue.

Anything & everything outside of the scope of other team leads; from merchandise design and orders to social media audits, seeking out and navigating new partnerships with businesses and community organizations, and managing any unique projects from idea formulation to completion. Devyn also fosters when she can and supports the rest of the team as needed.

JOAN HOFFER-DARLING, Accounting & Finance Support

Assists with all financial month end and year end reporting requirements. Looks after any items the team needs assistance with including events, transports and fostering. Coordinating of flights back to the north for dogs that are being sent back home.

Fosters Mama's that are being returned back to the north once they have had their puppies with some pampering time before they head back. Supports the team wherever needed.
