

Marcos Carvajal — Brief Biography

Marcos Carvajal is a multidisciplinary artist, educator, and designer with an extensive career spanning visual arts, art education, graphic design, and cultural exchange. Educated at institutions including the School of the Museum of Fine Arts in Boston, Cambridge College, and the Art Institute of Pittsburgh, he combines formal training in fine arts, design and education with decades of professional experience.

Throughout his career, Carvajal has worked as a graphic designer, illustrator, and art director for major organizations such as Burger King World Headquarters, GAC Properties Corporation, and advertising and environmental design firms in Miami and Puerto Rico. As an artist and consultant, he founded studios and galleries in Boston, Salem, Puerto Rico, and Sarasota, promoting interdisciplinary and community-based art practices.

An accomplished educator, he has taught at the School of the Museum of Fine Arts Boston, Montserrat College of Art, Cambridge College, the University of Puerto Rico, and Altos de Jájome School of Art. His innovative courses integrate visual arts, cultural studies, and creative teaching methodologies. Through Travel & Learn he also developed cultural travel programs fostering artistic and educational exchange with Cuba and Puerto Rico. His artwork has been exhibited internationally in the United States, Puerto Rico, and Cuba.
