- 1. Established a strong support for Burkina Faso decolonization process.
- 2. Updated International Press Message.
- 3. Continuously processing strong/worthy student recommendations.
- 4. Established a strong support for the Niger decolonization process.
- 5. Updated our transparency report to the Federal non profit database in the U.S.
- 6.Recognized and addressed the New York City housing crisis by assisting hundreds of New York City residents' assistance and support.
- 7.EWF became a community advocacy organization to legally assist immigrants and African Americans with crisis situations in New York City.

- 8. Updated our State of Emergency.
- 9. Finalized and filed our first official Governmental Charter Document.
- 10.Established employee exemptions.
- 11. Established governmental insurance policy for upcoming events.
- 12. Had a successful convention meeting.
- 13. Held first NYC event at Jackie Robinson Park.
- 14. Opened translation services for New York City immigrants with the ability to service twenty-five to one hundred African languages.

- 16.Completed an extensive report on the political corruption in Jamaica, West Indies and made it public.
